KPDN digesa tangani kenaikan harga sayur, buah

Georgetown: Persatuan Pengguna Pula Pinang (CAP) menggesa Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak Hidup (KPDN) bersama Lembaga Pemasaran Pertanian Persekutuan (FAMA), mengambil tindakan segera bagi menangani isu kenaikan harga sayur-sayuran dan buah-buahan tempatan di pasar.

Ia susulan tinjauan CAP baru-baru ini yang mendedahkan kenaikan harga mendadak dalam tempoh hanya dua minggu.

Presiden CAP, Mohideen Abdul Kader, berkata melalui tinjauan harga kacang didapati melonjak daripada RM9 kepada RM17.50 sekilogram dan bendi daripada RM7 kepada RM12.50.

Sementara harga kacang panjang daripada RM8 kepada RM20; sawi daripada RM6 kepada RM12 dan cili merah daripada RM8 kepada RM18.

"Kenaikan mendadak itu dikaitkan dengan kekurangan bekalan disebabkan musim hujan baru-baru ini dan peniaga sudah diberi amaran harga sayur-sayuran dan buah-buahan boleh meningkat lagi.

"Memandangkan musim hujan belum reda, Malaysia sepatutnya menghentikan eksport ikan dan sayur-sayuran ke negara lain dan mengutamakan permintaan tempatan sehingga musim hujan berakhir," katanya menerusi kenyataan, semalam.

Mohideen berkata, CAP juga menggesa Unit Pengurusan KPDN menyiasat kenaikan harga yang mendadak itu sehingga membebankan orang ramai terutama golongan miskin dan berpendapatan rendah.

Katanya, kenaikan harga itu boleh memberi kesan serius kepada diet isi rumah berpendapatan rendah kerana mereka mungkin terpaksa mengurangkan barang makanan penting kerana kos yang lebih tinggi.

"Walaupun gesaan dilakukan berulang kali supaya tindakan diambil, CAP mendapat FAMA tidak mengambil langkah mencukupi dan berkesan bagi mengawal pemasaran dan pengedaran sayur-sayuran. Ia bermakna tuntutan kami diabaikan," katanya.

Mohideen berkata, CAP menggesa Kementerian Pertanian dan Keterjaminan Makanan (KPKM) meningkatkan kecekapan saluran pengedaran makanan.

"Fungsi orang tengah perlu dikurangkan bagi mewujudkan pasaran langsung dan menambah baik rantaian bekalan yang boleh membantu mengurangkan kos," katanya.

CAP desak segera tangani harga sayur-sayuran

Dua minggu harga sayur naik mendadak

GEORGE TOWN – Persatuan Pengguna Pulau Pinang (CAP) menggesa Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak Hidup (KPDN) serta Lembaga Pemasaran Pertanian Persekutuan (FAMA) mengambil tindakan segera bagi menangani kenaikan harga sayur-sayuran dan buah-buahan tempatan pada masa ini.

Presiden CAP, Mohideen Abdul Kader berkata, ini kerana tinjauan CAP baru-baru mendapati berlaku kenaikan harga sayur dan buah-buahan yang mendadak dalam tempoh hanya dua minggu.

"Tinjauan mendapati harga bendi naik daripada RM7 kepada

RM12.50, kacang panjang daripada RM8 kepada RM20.

"Selain itu harga sawi meningkat daripada RM6 kepada RM12 dan cili merah daripada RM8 kepada RM18," katanya di sini semalam.

Kata Mohideen, kenaikan harga yang mendadak ini telah dikaitkan dengan kekurangan barang ini disebabkan oleh musim hujan baru-baru ini.

"Peniaga telah diberi amaran bahawa harga sayur-sayuran dan buah-buahan boleh meningkat lagi.

"Memandangkan musim hujan masih belum reda, Malaysia sepatutnya menghentikan eksport ikan dan sayur-sayuran ke negara lain dan mengutamakan permintaan tempatan sehingga

musim hujan berakhir," katanya.

Tambahnya, CAP juga menggesa unit penguatkuasaan KPDN untuk menyiasat kenaikan harga yang mendadak ini, yang telah menyebabkan kesukaran yang ketara kepada golongan miskin dan berpendapatan rendah.

"Kenaikan harga ini boleh memberikan kesan serius kepada diet isi rumah berpendapatan rendah kerana mereka mungkin terpaksa mengurangkan barang makanan penting berikut kos yang lebih tinggi.

"Walaupun gesaan berulang kali agar tindakan diambil, CAP mendapati tiada langkah yang mencukupi dan berkesan untuk mengawal pemasaran dan pengedaran sayur-sayuran. Tunutan kami diabaikan," katanya.

KPDN ambil serius aduan CAP

GEORGE TOWN - Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) mengambil serius aduan Persatuan Pengguna Pulau Pinang (CAP) berhubung isu kenaikan harga bahan mentah di negeri ini.

Pengarah KPDN Pulau Pinang, S Jegan berkata, pihaknya sentiasa melaksanakan penguatkuasaan dan periksaan bagi memastikan harga barang sentiasa terkawal bagi menangani isu kenaikan harga barang.

Menurut Jegan, pihaknya melaksanakan pelbagai pendekatan berterusan dan agresif melalui periksaan secara harian di pasar awam, pasar pagi, pasar malam, pasar tani dan pasar raya.

"Sehingga 30 November lalu, sebanyak 48,955 pemeriksaan dilakukan dengan 344 tindakan kes diambil terhadap peniaga yang melakukan kesalahan mengikut Akta Kawalan Harga dan Antipencatutan (AKHAP) 2011.

"Selain itu, KPDN akan terus melaksanakan sesi libat urus bersama pihak berkepentingan seperti Lembaga Pemasaran Pertanian Persekutuan (FAMA) dan pemain industri lain bagi memastikan harga barang sentiasa dipantau ketika negara mengalami cuaca tidak menentu," katanya ketika dihubungi pada Isnin.

Katanya, KPDN akan mengambil tindakan tegas terhadap peniaga yang didapati melanggar undang-undang atau mencatut.

"Sebanyak 105 Notis Pengesahan Maklumat Barang (NPMB) dikeluarkan KPDN Pulau Pinang kepada peniaga borong dan runcit berdasarkan isu kenaikan harga barang termasuk sayur-sayuran seperti sawi, kacang, kacang panjang, kacang ben-di dan cili merah.

"Individu dikesan melakukan kesalahan mengikut AKHAP 2011 boleh didenda sehingga RM100,000 atau penjara maksimum tiga tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali," kata beliau.

Dalam pada itu, Jegan menasihatkan pengguna membuat perbandingan harga dan memilih premis menawarkan harga yang berpatutan.

KPDN Labuan gagalkan cubaan seleleweng 500 liter diesel

LABUAN: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Labuan menggagalkan cubaan menyeleweng 500 liter diesel bersubsidi menerusi Ops Tiris 3.0 - Kita Gempur di sini, Ahad lepas.

Pengarah KPDN Labuan Junaidah Arbain berkata diesel berkenaan ditemukan di dalam sebuah kenderaan pacuan empat roda (4WD) bernombor pendaftaran tempatan yang diperiksa di sebuah stesen minyak.

"Operasi pada 9.49 pagi itu telah menahan dan memeriksa kenderaan terbabit yang didapati mempunyai tangki besi tambahan pada struktur kenderaan."

"Pemeriksaan lanjut menemukan diesel berkenaan yang telah selesai diisi

ke dalam tangki besi tambahan itu, dengan nilai keseluruhan sitaan RM16,075," katanya kepada Bernama, Isnin.

Beliau berkata pemandu kenderaan terbabit iaitu lelaki berusia 51 tahun telah direkodkan keterangan untuk membantu siasatan mengikut Seksyen 21 Akta Kawalan bekalan 1961.

Junaidah berkata operasi itu dijalankan hasil risikan selama seminggu selepas KPDN menerima aduan daripada orang awam berkaitan kegiatan itu.

"Kejayaan ini membuktikan maklumat orang awam sangat penting dalam membantu KPDN membanteras salah laku berkaitan barangang kawalan bersubsidi dan aktiviti penyelewengan," katanya. — Bernama

Seized – Labuan vehicle carrying subsidised diesel

LABUAN: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) seized a locally registered vehicle carrying subsidised diesel worth RM16,075 during its Op Tiris 3.0 – Kita Gempur operation at a petrol station on Dec 8.

KPDN Labuan Director Junaidah Arbain said the Ministry's enforcement team inspected a four-wheel-drive vehicle equipped with an additional iron tank at 9:49am.

"During the inspection, 500 litres of diesel, believed to be subsidised, were discovered. The driver, a 51-year-old local, was detained for questioning," she said, Monday.

The case is being investigated under Section 21 of the Control of Supplies Act 1961, which imposes penalties of up to a RM1 million fine, imprisonment for up to three years, or both, for first-time individual offenders, while companies may face

fines of up to RM2 million.

She noted that the operation was the result of a week-long intelligence effort based on public complaints.

"KPDN Labuan credits community involvement for this success and remains steadfast in combating the misappropriation of controlled and subsidised items.

"We encourage the public to continue reporting such suspicious activities to facilitate enforcement," she added.

Copyright infringement: KPDN blocks access to 3,553 websites

THE Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) has blocked access to 3,553 websites, found to be in violation of the Copyright Act 1987 for engaging in piracy activities, between 2021 and October 2024.

Responding on behalf of KPDN, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa disclosed that the action included websites which distributed copyrighted works, such as Syurga Itu Bukan Mudah, Jangan Lupa Janji, and Chinta Wrong Direction.

Additionally, she said that 40 other actions were taken to block websites involved in the sale of counterfeit goods and services, both online and offline, which led to enforcement actions for criminal offences.

She highlighted that those found guilty of such violations could face a fine of no less than RM1 million, or imprisonment for up to five years, as stipulated under Sections 99 to 102 of the Trademark Act 2019.

Dr Zaliha was responding to a question from Syahredzan Johan (PH-Bangi), on the

number of websites which have been blocked due to infringement of intellectual property rights, and whether the Cyber Copyright Enforcement (CyCore) programme is still being implemented.

She explained that the CyCore programme, launched by the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture (Motac) in 2021, continues to be implemented. The programme aims to establish a collaborative platform between the ministry and copyright holders, to address the distribution of digital piracy online, per the legal frameworks of the Copyright Act 1987 and the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998.

"This effort is a collaboration between the Motac and the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), internet service providers (ISPs), the creative industry and local copyright owners, in implementing access blocking actions on websites found to be distributing infringing copies, involving new local film works which were first screened in digital form via the internet," she said.

Pacuan empat roda diubahsuai untuk aktiviti penyelewengan diesel ditahan

LABUAN: Sebuah pacuan empat roda ditahan selepas dikesan diubahsuai dipercayai untuk tujuan menyeleweng minyak diesel bersubsidi dalam operasi Ops Tiris 3.0 di daerah ini, Ahad lalu.

Operasi jam 9.49 pagi yang dijalankan pasukan Kita Gempur, Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak Hidup (KPDN) itu berjaya merampas kira-kira 500 liter minyak diesel.

Pengarah KPDN Labuan, Junaidah Arbaian berkata, semua minyak yang diisi ke dalam tangki besi tambahan itu terus dirampas dan sitaan dianggarkan bernilai RM16,075.

Katanya, pasukan operasi turut menahan seorang lelaki tempatan berusia 51 tahun

yang merupakan pemandu kendaraan terlibat.

"Suspek ditahan untuk diambil keterangan bagi membantu siasatan mengikut Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 (Akta 122).

"Sebagai tindakan lanjut, kes ini akan disiasat mengikut Seksyen 21 Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 (Akta 122) kerana memiliki barang kawalan dengan tujuan untuk melakukan kesalahan," katanya dalam kenyataan media yang dikeluarkan, semalam.

Junaidah berkata, jika sabit kesalahan, pesalah boleh dikenakan hukuman denda berkata, semua minyak yang diisi ke dalam tangki besi tambahan itu terus dirampas dan sitaan dianggarkan bernilai RM16,075.

Katanya, bagi syarikat pula, jika sabit kesalahan boleh membawa hukuman denda

tidak melebihi RM2 juta, manakala bagi kesalahan berikutnya tidak melebihi RM5 juta.

Sementara itu, Junaidah berkata, operasi dijalankan hasil aduan dan maklumat awam serta risikan selama seminggu yang dijalankan bahagian penguat kuasa KPDN Labuan.

Katanya, kejayaan ini membuktikan maklumat orang awam amat penting dalam membantu KPDN membanteras salah laku berkaitan barang kawalan bersubsidi dan aktiviti penyelewangan.

"KPDN Labuan akan terus menjalankan pemeriksaan dan pemantauan secara berterusan ke atas semua kegiatan berkaitan barang kawalan di Wilayah ini agar tidak berlaku sebarang bentuk penyelewangan terhadap barang kawalan berkenaan.

"Orang ramai yang mempunyai maklumat mengenai sebarang aktiviti yang melanggar perundangan boleh menjadi mata dan telinga bagi menyalurkan aduan kepada pihak KPDN."

Sehubungan itu, Junaidah berkata, orang ramai yang mempunyai maklumat berkenaan aktiviti salah laku berkaitan barang kawalan boleh disalurkan kepada pihak KPDN untuk tindakan selanjutnya.

Katanya, sebarang maklumat boleh disalurkan melalui Aplikasi WhatsApp ditanian 019-848 8000 atau menerusi Portal e-Aduan KPDN iaitu <http://eaduan.kpdn.gov.my>. "Maklumat turut boleh disalurkan menerusi talian Call Centre 1-800-886-800 atau Aplikasi Telefon Pintar Ez ADU KPDN," katanya.
