KPDN mendapati tiada unsur pencatutan

Tiada peniaga naik harga sebab diesel

KUALA LUMPUR – Sebanyak 21,038 premis telah diperiksa dalam Ops Kesan 2.0 sejak 8 Jun bagi memastikan tiada kenaikan harga yang tidak munasabah, khususnya selepas penyasaran diesel bersubsidi bermula baru-baru ini.

Dalam pemeriksaan yang telah dilakukan itu, Timbalan Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak (KPDN) Fauziah Salleh berkata, pihaknya tidak mengesang sebarang aktiviti pencatutan.

"Maklumat yang kita terima dia tidak melibatkan pencatutan, harga yang tidak munasabah itu tidak ada, masih lagi terkawal."

Turun naik itu biasa, kita tak boleh kawal semua dalam pasaran terbuka, kalau kita kawal semua, pengeluar mungkin tidak mahu langsung mengeluarkan bahan tersebut.

"Tapi kita juga mesti pastikan bekalan itu ada, bukan setakat mengawal harga, jadi dalam pasaran ekonomi terbuka kita mesti pastikan ada bekalan, pastikan juga harga terkawal," katanya di Dewan Negara semalam.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika menjawab pertanyaan Senator Hussin Ismail yang meminta kerajaan menyatakan langkah-langkah Kementerian bagi menangani inflasi dan kesan ber-ganda kenaikan harga barang keperluan dan bahan binaan akhirnya.

bat kenaikan harga diesel tertinggi dalam sejarah iaitu sebanyak RM1.20.

Jelas Fauziah lagi, kementerian juga menyediakan saluran aduan untuk mana-mana pihak membuat aduan sekiranya berlaku kenaikan harga tidak munasabah di mana-mana premis.

"Aduan juga boleh dikemukakan sekiranya terdapat kekurangan atau ketidadaan bekalan di mana-mana premis," katanya.

Fuziah juga mencadangkan pihak yang terlibat dalam sektor pertanian untuk mengemukakan memorandum kepada kementerian terlibat bagi mendapatkan subsidi diesel bersasar dalam mengurangkan kos pertanian ketika ini.

RM79.7m for programme to ease cost of living in Sabah

KINABATANGAN: The Government has allocated RM79.7 million so far for the Distribution Programme of Necessary Goods, Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) and Community Drumming in Sabah, said Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Minister Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali (pic).

He said this programme has been implemented in 71 zones, involving a total 219 distribution areas as well as 654 points of sale.

"This has given a positive impact to more than 529,948 people in the State. In Sandakan, the programme involves 19 zones covering 51 areas and not only benefits 109,314 rural residents, but small traders also enjoy an abundance of sustenance," he said.

He said this in a statement after officiating the Scheduled Controlled Goods Licence (CSA) Ceremony for the official operation of the Distribution Programme of Necessary Goods, LPG and Community Drumming for the Abai Zone, near here, Monday.

Armizan said the Government is expanding the implementation of the programme by adding two more new zones in Sabah, namely the Abai Zone, Kinabatangan and Gana Zone, Kota Marudu.

He said the selection of Kampung Abai as a new zone in this implementation pro-



gramme is to ensure 350 residents in the area will have access to basic necessities, controlled items and subsidised controlled items at the same prices in Sandakan city.

"Among the items involved are rice, refined white sugar, wheat flour, cooking oil, LPG, RON95 petrol and diesel in the listed rural areas.

Before the programme's expansion, residents of Kampung Abai obtained essential items such as cooking oil packets and refined white sugar at a price of RM3.50 compared to the controlled price of RM2.50 and RM2.85. As for LPG, residents purchased it at a rate of RM45 per barrel, compared to the controlled price of RM26.60/barrel," he said.

He said the Price Standardisation for the Distribution of Necessary Goods, LPG and Community Drumming programme, implemented by his Ministry, is a manifestation of the Madani government's concern to look into the needs of the people while further increasing the effectiveness of providing services in helping to ease the burden of the cost of living.

He also said for this year, the Federal Government allocated RM225 million for this implementation programme involving six states, namely Sabah, Sarawak, Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang and Kedah.

"This involves the granting of government subsidies through the appointed transporter company that provides the service of transporting essential items and selected controlled items from the point of supply to the point of sale," he added.

244 premises found to have elements of profiteering: KPDN

A TOTAL of 244 out of 21,038 premises inspected by the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) were found to have elements of profiteering since Ops Kesan 2.0 was launched on June 8.

Deputy Minister of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Datuk Fuziah Salleh said written notices to the premises involved had been issued.

"The written notice is like a letter of instruction because they have to provide a lot of information such as the amount of transportation costs, production and so on.

"If there is an element of profiteering, investigation papers will be opened and if found guilty, they will be investigated under the Price Control and Anti-Profitteering Act 2011," she said during a question and answer session at Dewan Negara, Monday.

She said this when replying a supplementary question by Senator Datuk Salehuddin Saidin who wanted to know KPDN's action against premises that sell goods at exorbitant prices.

Ops Kesan 2.0 aims to ensure that there is no excessive increase in the price of goods and services following the adjustment of diesel retail price announced by the government.

Meanwhile, in response to a question

by Senator Hussin Ismail who was curious about the diesel subsidy for the group of agricultural vehicles that use diesel, Fuziah said the parties involved can submit an appeal to obtain a diesel subsidy to the Appeals Committee handled by the Ministry of Finance (MOF).

"So far, 'backhoes' are not included in the 23 categories that receive diesel subsidies because they provide service and not carry goods.

"They can bring a proposal for a memorandum of engagement with the ministries involved because we at KPDN are implementing it and I have also received appeals submitted by some non-governmental organisations (NGOs) representing them," she said.

Fuziah also said KPDN has identified four construction companies suspected of supplying goods at high prices and the companies involved have been called to KPDN headquarters to give an explanation.

"It is to explain and give justification if it is true or not that there is profiteering," she said.

She was replying a question by Hussin who wanted to know the measures taken by KPDN to deal with inflation and the double effect of the increase in the price of essential goods and building materials following the diesel subsidy adjustment.

KPDN Pulau Pinang lupsus 49,488 barang rampasan bernilai RM2.34 Juta

BUKIT MERTAJAM: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Pulau Pinang melupuskan 49,488 unit pelbagai barang rampasan bernilai RM2.34 juta dalam tempoh enam bulan pertama tahun ini.

Pengarah KPDN negeri S. Jegar berkata kesemua barang itu hasil rampasan daripada 59 kes melibatkan pelbagai kesalahan di bawah Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961, Akta Perihal Dagangan 2011, Akta Timbang dan Sukat 1972, Akta Kawalan Harga dan Antipencatutan 2011, Akta Cap Dagangan 2019 dan Akta Pelindungan Pengguna 1999.

“Kesemua kesterbabit telah selesai proses pendakwaan dan kompaun, seterusnya mendapat kebenaran untuk dilupuskan.

“Ekhibit yang dilupuskan terdiri daripada pelbagai se- luar, baju, kasut, topi, produk makanan dan penjagaan kesihatan serta aksesori dan peranti elektronik berjenama tiruan,” katanya pada sidang media program Pelupusan Eksibit Mega KPDN Pulau Pinang di Kompleks Penyimpanan KPDN Pulau Pinang dekat Bukit Minyak di sini semalam.

Beliau berkata, pelupusan dari Januari hingga Jun itu adalah tertinggi berbanding tahun sebelumnya, iaitu sepanjang tahun lepas pihaknya melupuskan pelbagai barang rampasan bernilai RM898,155.88 membabitkan 94 kes manakala pada 2022 pelbagai barang bernilai RM541,142.45 melibatkan 152 kes.

Jegan berkata sepanjang tahun ini Bahagian Pen-

guat Kuasa KPDN Pulau Pinang mempergiat aktiviti penguatkuasaan dan pemeriksaan berkaitan bekalan, harga, antipencatutan, ketirisan, barang tiruan, halal, sewa beli, skim antipiramid, jualan langsung, penipuan dalam talian dan sebagainya.

“Bermula 1 Januari hingga 30 Jun lepas, KPDN Pulau Pinang telah memeriksa 22,143 premis dan 233 tindakan kes telah dihasilkan melibatkan pelbagai kesalahan dengan nilai rampasan RM1.58 juta.

“Kompaun bernilai RM94,600 telah dikeluarkan melibatkan 124 kes manakala tiga kes pula melibatkan tindakan pendakwaan di mahkamah dengan jumlah keseluruhan denda sebanyak RM52,000,” katanya. — Bernama

THE Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) said more than 300 *Jualan Rahmah* events have been held since January across all 26 parliamentary constituencies in Johor.

State KPDN director Lilis Saslinda Purnomo said the ministry was committed to ensuring the public could buy basic goods at affordable prices through the initiative.

"Since the beginning of the year, we have held 341 *Jualan Rahmah* events – 306 were mobile programmes, 27 were held outdoors and eight indoors.

"On top of that, we also organised several special *Jualan Rahmah Madani* events during major festivals in the country," she said after visiting an outdoor *Jualan Rahmah* programme at Hospital Sultanah Aminah (HSA) in Johor Baru.

Lilis Saslinda said consumers were able to enjoy discounts of between 10% and 30% through the *Jualan Rahmah* initiative.

"We hope that this will help to reduce the people's burden, especially with the rising cost of living," she said.

"I also urge the public to lodge official complaints with the ministry if they come

across operators that fail to adhere to proper business practices, instead of complaining on social media.

"While consumers are free to post their complaints on social media, they also need to make an official report so

that the ministry can take prompt action."

Lilis Saslinda said this was also to prevent the businesses involved from hiding evidence that could prove their wrongdoing before enforcement officers could carry out their investigations.

She said Johor KPDN was open to organising more *Jualan Rahmah* events in hospitals if there was a need.

Johor Health Department director Dr Mohtar Pungut Ahmad, who was also present, said it welcomed the offer to organise similar initiatives at other hospitals and was prepared to give its assistance.

"This is the second time a *Jualan Rahmah* event is held in a hospital in Johor.

"The first one was at Hospital Sultan Ismail (HSI).

"We welcome such initiatives as it will benefit both the public and medical staff who may not have time to go grocery shopping as they have to focus on their duties," he said. — By VENESA DEVI
