# Banteras ketirisan minyak masak peket

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Kerajaan melakukan operasi besar-besaran bagi membanteras aktiviti penyelewangan minyak masak peket bersubsidi supaya kegiatan itu tidak terus berleluasa.

Ia berikutan terdapat pihak tidak bertanggungjawab terus menyalahgunakan

barang subsidi terutama minyak masak peket satu kilogram, umpamanya di restoran-restoran sedangkan ia dipe-runtukkan kepada golongan sasar yang layak.

Timbalan Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup, Fuziah Salleh berkata, sebanyak 60 juta peket minyak masak bersubsidi dikeluarkan setiap bulan.

Kata beliau, kerajaan menggunakan

satu sistem yang membantu menjelaki minyak masak tersebut daripada pembungkus kepada pemborong sehingga kepada peruncit.

“Peruncit pula diminta mengisi buku log bagi mengetahui minyak masak peket bersubsidi itu dijual kepada siapa, tetapi selepas itu kadangkala mereka tidak menyimpan buku tersebut dengan baik.

## Banteras ketirisan minyak masak peket

"Kebelakangan ini kita boleh lihat penguat kuasa kementerian bekerja 24 jam sehari untuk memastikan tidak berlaku ketirisan ke atas barang-barang bersubsidi terutama minyak masak peket.

"Namun, tetap ada pihak-pihak yang akan mengambil kesempatan. Contohnya, mereka menggunakan minyak masak subsidi ini di restoran. Jadi perkara ini akan dibanteras habis-habisan," katanya semasa Pertanyaan-Pertanyaan Bagi Jawab Lisan di Dewan Rakyat, semalam.

Beliau menjawab soalan tambahan Khoo Poay Tiong (PH-Kota Melaka) yang meminta kementerian menjelaskan mekanisme diambil untuk memastikan minyak masak peket bersubsidi hanya dijual kepada golongan sasar.

*Utusan Malaysia* melaporkan cadangan supaya kerajaan memansuhkan minyak masak peket subsidi dan digantikan dengan bantuan kewangan kepada golongan sasar bagi menangani isu penyeleweng serta ketirisan.

Berdasarkan laporan, dari pada kuota 60,000 tan metrik atau bersamaan 60 juta peket minyak masak bersubsidi satu kilogram sebulan di pasaran, 60 peratus digunakan oleh kumpulan peniaga mikro.

Malah, subsidi bahan keperluan harian tersebut turut dinikmati oleh 3.4 juta warga asing dengan had pembelian sebanyak tiga peket sama seperti warga tempatan.

Selain itu, wujud perbuatan yang mengambil kesempatan apabila ada sindiket membeli minyak masak bersubsidi pada harga RM2.50 sepeket, kemudian dicampur dengan minyak masak terpakai dan dijual semula antara RM3 hingga RM3.80 sekilogram.

Sementara itu, Fuziah ber-

kata, kerajaan akan memastikan penyasaran subsidi RON95 tidak memberi impak kepada harga barang keperluan.

"Faktor turun naik (harga barang keperluan) adalah faktor lebih global tetapi apa yang kementerian lakukan adalah memastikan bahawa segala tindakan (seperti) apabila kita menyasarkan subsidi diesel, kita memastikan penyasaran subsidi itu tidak meninggalkan kesan pada harga barang," katanya.

Sementara itu dalam perkembangan berkaitan, seramai 11 warga asing mengaku bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen Kajang, Selangor semalam atas pertuduhan memiliki bahan kawalan berjadual tanpa lesen sah, pertengahan-bulan lalu.

Mengikut pertuduhan, kesemua tertuduh warga Indonesia didakwa memiliki minyak masak seberat 4,000 kilogram dalam keadaan menimbulkan syak di rumah sewa mereka di Jalan Kajang Jaya 1, pada pukul 8.35 malam, 12 November lalu.

Perbuatan itu didakwa dibawah Seksyen 21 Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 yang boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen 22(1) akta sama dan dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan.

Seksyen itu memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum tiga tahun dan denda tidak melebihi RM1,000,000 atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Bagi kesalahan seterusnya, memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum lima tahun atau denda tidak melebihi RM3,000,000 atau kedua-dua sekali, jika sabit kesalahan.

Tertuduh-tertuduh terlibat ialah Taufiq, 31; Muhammad Saifun Nur, 25; Mahdi Ismail, 48; Atriman Nurdin, 33; Muhammad Nazari, 48; Muhammad Saidi, 42; Munawar 25; Ricky, 54; Ikramullah 23; Muhammad Yani, 20; dan Adrian, 29.

Pegawai Pendakwa, Muhammad Saiful Saaidin tidak mencadangkan sebarang jaminan dan memohon satu tarikh baharu untuk laporan kimia.

"Bagi kes ini, kesemua tertuduh tidak ditawarkan sebarang jaminan kerana tidak mempunyai alamat tetap dan bukan warganegara Malaysia. Pihak pendakwaan juga memohon kesemua tertuduh diletakkan di Penjara Satelit Kuala Langat," kata Saiful.

Kesemua tertuduh yang tidak diwakili peguam itu tidak memohon sebarang rayuan.

Hakim Mazualina Abdul Rashid menetapkan 17 Disember ini bagi sebutan semula kes.

# Subsidi RON95 ambil kira indikator kos sara hidup rakyat

**Indikator** kos sara hidup rakyat termasuk tanggungan dan pekerjaan individu, akan diambil perkiraan dalam penyaluran subsidi petrol RON95 kelak.

Timbalan Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup, Fuziah Salleh, berkata indikator itu merangkumi statistik Perbelanjaan Asas Kehidupan Wajar (PAKW) dan Indeks Kos Sara Hidup (IKSH), dibangunkan Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM).

“Memang diambil kira semua perkara yang membabitkan perbelanjaan tetapi berkenaan RON95, sekiranya penyasaran subsidi berlaku kelak, tentunya ia akan ada impak kepada isi rumah yang menggunakan RON95.

“Jadi, dalam kajian yang dibangunkan DOSM, dimana KPDN turut serta diberi taklimat, memang (indikator kos sara hidup ini) diambil kira.

“Maknanya, kalau ada dua kereta, kalau ada dua orang bekerja, isteri dan suami bekerja, anak sekolah yang kecil, yang pergi sekolah, belajar universiti, semua termasuk dalam perkiraan indikator kos sara hidup ini,” katanya menjawab soalan tambahan Azahari Hasan (PN-Padang Rengas) di Dewan Rakyat semalam.

minggu lalu melancarkan statistik baharu bagi indikator kos sara hidup yang merangkumi PAKW dan IKSH, sebagai panduan dalam perancangan dasar bersesuaian, malah rujukan kepada rakyat dalam merancang dan menguruskan perbelanjaan.

Terdahulu, menjawab soalan Azahari berkenaan perancangan kementerian bagi menangani masalah kenaikan harga barang, secara langsung meningkatkan inflasi, Fuziah berkata, kerajaan meneruskan Program Jualan Rahmah dan Agro MADANI untuk jualan murah tahun depan.

“Kita akan adakan dua kali sebulan di setiap DUN (Dewan Undangan Negeri) untuk Program Jualan Rahmah ini,” katanya.

Menjawab soalan tambahan Khoo Poay Tiong (PH-Kota Melaka) mengenai ketirisan subsidi minyak masak, beliau berkata, kerajaan membanteras secara habisan-habisan tindakan peniaga yang didapati sewenang-wenangnya menggunakan minyak paket subsidi.

“Sebanyak 60 juta peket minyak masak subsidi dikeluarkan setiap bulan. Jadi, penguatkuasaan amat penting supaya tidak berlaku ketirisan,” katanya.

## Tanggungan keluarga, status kerja jadi indikator salur subsidi RON95

**KUALA LUMPUR** — Tanggungan dalam keluarga serta status pekerjaan akan turut diambil kira sebagai sebahagian daripada indikator kos sara hidup dalam memutuskan kriteria penyaluran subsidi RON95.

Timbalan Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN), Fuziah Salleh berkata, ia merangkumi statistik Perbelanjaan Asas Kehidupan Wajar (PAKW) dan Indeks Kos Sara eHidup (IKSH) yang dibangunkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM).

"Sekiranya penyaluran subsidi RON95 berlaku kelak, tentunya ia akan ada impak kepada isi rumah yang menggunakan RON95. Dalam kajian yang dibangunkan DOSM di mana KPDN turut diberi taktimat, memang indikator ini diambil kira.

"Kalau ada dua kereta, isteri dan suami bekerja, anak sekolah, anak belajar universiti, semua ini termasuk dalam perkiraan indikator kos sara hidup ini," katanya pada sidang Dewan Rakyat di sini semalam.

Beliau menjawab soalan

tambahan Azahari Hasan (**PN Padang Rengas**) berhubung indikator kos sara hidup dalam memutuskan kriteria penyaluran subsidi RON95 kepada rakyat.

Menjawab soalan asal Azahari, Fuziah berkata, kerajaan akan meneruskan Program Jualan Rahmah dan Agra Madani untuk jualan murah pada tahun depan bagi membantu rakyat berhadapan isu kenaikan harga barang.

Jelas beliau, program berkenaan akan adakan dua kali sebulan di setiap Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN).

# Dependents, job status factors in RON95 subsidy

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The number of dependents and employment status will be among the considerations when assessing a person's eligibility for the RON95 subsidy.

Deputy Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister Fuziah Salleh said the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) had developed the Basic Expenses for Decent Living (PAKW) indicator and the Cost of Living Index (IKSH) to be part of the assessment.

"All factors involving expenditure have been taken into account. However, regarding

RON95, if the targeting of subsidy takes place in the future, it will definitely impact households that rely on RON95.

"Therefore, in the study developed by DOSM, in which the ministry was briefed, these living cost indicators have been considered.

"This means if a household has two cars, if the husband and wife are working and if there are children who are schooling... all these factors are included in the calculation of the living cost indicators," she said in reply to Azahari Hasan (PN-Padang Rengas) in the Dewan Rakyat yesterday.

Earlier this month, DOSM re-

leased its inaugural Cost of Living Indicators (CLI) 2023.

Chief statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin said the CLI included the PAKW and IKSH.

He said PAKW was analysed based on demographic details, including household characteristics, size and location.

During the tabling of the 2025 Budget on Oct 18, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said the subsidy for RON95 petrol would be rolled out in the middle of next year.

# Keeping fuel aid on target

## RON95 subsidy will consider many factors, says deputy minister

FACTORS such as number of dependents and employment status will be taken into account in determining a household's eligibility and quantum of RON95 fuel subsidies, says the Deputy Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister.

Fuziah Salleh said the indicators include the Basic Living Expenses Statistics (PAKW) and the Cost of Living Index (IKSH) that have been developed by the Statistics Department.

"All aspects related to expenses are taken into account. Regarding RON95, if subsidy targeting is implemented, it will undoubtedly have an impact on households that rely on RON95."

"In the study developed by the Statistics Department, on which the ministry was briefed, indicators such as dependents and cost of living are indeed considered."

"This means that factors like owning two cars, both husband and wife being employed, having young children in school, or children attending university, are all

part of the cost of living indicators," she told the Dewan Rakyat yesterday in response to Azahari Hasan (PN-Padang Rengas).

Last week, the Statistics Department introduced new statistics for cost of living indicators, including PAKW and IKSH, aimed at guiding policy planning and

serving as a reference for the public to plan and manage their finances.

Earlier, in response to Azahari's primary question regarding the ministry's plans to address the rising prices of goods, Fuziah said the government will continue the Rahmah Sales programme and

Agro Madani initiative to offer low-cost goods next year.

"These Rahmah Sales will be held twice a month in every state assembly constituency," she said.

Addressing a supplementary question from Khoo Poay Tiong (PH-Kota Melaka) on the leakage of subsidised cooking oil packets, Fuziah said the government is taking strict action against traders found to be misusing these cooking oil packets.

According to her, a total of 60 million subsidised cooking oil packets are produced every month.

"Therefore, strict enforcement is crucial to prevent leakage of subsidised goods, particularly cooking oil packets.

"However, some parties still take advantage, such as using subsidised cooking oil in restaurants.

"This will be tackled vigorously, and it is the responsibility of our enforcement teams. We will ensure no leakages occur," she added.

## Appellate court reserves judgment in MyCC's appeal against Grab on quashing RM86.77 mil proposed decision

PUTRAJAYA (Nov 18): A three-member Court of Appeal bench had reserved its judgment in giving a decision over the appeal by Malaysia Competition Commission (MyCC) over a High Court's decision last year that quashed its "proposed decision" by imposing a proposed fine of RM86.77 million against Grab Holdings Inc, together with its subsidiaries GrabCar Sdn Bhd and MyTaksi Sdn Bhd.

The proposed fine on Grab, which was imposed on Oct 3, 2019, is for allegedly abusing its dominant position to restrict its drivers from promoting other e-hailing platforms.

Judge Datuk S Nantha Balan, who led the bench on Monday, said the panel required some time after hearing heavy arguments on the matter from MyCC and Grab in the morning and afternoon.

The other members of the bench were Datuk Dr Lim Chong Fong and Datuk Ahmad Kamal Md Shahid.

Earlier senior counsel Tan Sri Tommy Thomas, who appeared with Mervyn Lai, said MyCC's action on Oct 3, 2019, was a proposed decision and not a final or conclusive decision, and hence the High Court was wrong last year, to allow the judicial review to quash a proposed decision by MyCC.

Going into the administrative law of judicial review, Thomas said a review against a government authority is normally made once a decision is finalised.

"Here it is a proposed decision on the imposition of a fine. MyCC has not made a final or conclusive decision on whether there was an infringement or non-infringement of the Competition Act 2010 (CA 2010) or competition law," said Thomas.

Furthermore, he added the matter has yet to come to a final determination as MyCC had only finished its probe.

### Action by Grab premature

He further went into the various provisions in the CA 2010, citing that Grab's action was premature as under Section 36 of the CA under proposed decision, whatever is stated is not amenable to judicial review.

In the proposed decision, Thomas said it was like issuing a show cause to Grab on



wanting to seek answers over the possible action to be taken.

"There are cases when there was a proposed decision but, in the end, after further consideration and investigation, MyCC finds there was no infringement, while in some [cases] after that we find there is infringement, and a penalty is imposed."

"Once a decision is made whether there is an infringement [under Section 40] or no infringement [Section 39] then there is still an avenue for the aggrieved party to go to the Consumer Appeal Tribunal (CAT). If they felt aggrieved, they could then file a judicial review to court. However, it should not be done before that at the proposed decision stage," Thomas added.

"Until a Final Decision is issued, a party is not affected in any way by a proposed decision, as it cannot be enforced by MyCC. The High Court has failed to appreciate this," he added.

Thomas further submitted that a party has no right to be heard in court, during the investigative process where the proposed decision is made.

He added that Grab's complaint in filing the review was that their right to be heard was violated as they were not told over the Radzwan's complaint which was investigated along with other complaints.

"By right this is the investigative process and during this stage, Grab do not have a right to be heard. They only can respond after the proposed decision is made," he added.

### Grab says there was invalid investigation and hence court right to quash

Datuk Malik Intiaz Sarwar for Grab in reply said the High Court decision was right to quash the proposed decision, and this follows a warning after the proposed decision that a penalty of RM15,000 can be imposed daily on the initial fine of RM86.72 million.

He said the decision to issue the proposed decision was made not in accordance with the law and that was why his client filed the judicial review to challenge the decision.

"While MyCC had investigated the complaints made in 2018, it had also touched on the Radzwan complaint which Grab was not asked to give any feedback on."

"Under Section 36 of the Competition Act, the proposed decision can be made after it had duly completed the investigation process. It is plain that such an investigation must be valid in law, and that the fact of a valid investigation is a condition to MyCC's jurisdiction to issue a proposed decision. If such a condition, or if the investigation is not considered valid, then it runs foul to the proposed decision which is considered ultra vires," Malik added.

He further pointed to the daily penalty of RM15,000 should the RM86.72 million not be paid as another ground for his client to seek a review. If the penalty is not challenged, Malik argued that his client is likely to face a heavy financial loss.

Malik said when Grab was not granted leave initially in the judicial review, and appealed to the Court of Appeal, the appellate court in granting leave (permission) for the merits to be heard held that the CA does not provide for any internal remedy aimed at reviewing a decision by MyCC to issue a "proposed decision" under Section 36(1) of the CA.

For these reasons, he added when the Federal Court also denied MyCC leave to appeal, the matter was reverted to the High Court for determination, where it found there was this violation with regards to the investigations.

In allowing Grab's judicial review, then High Court judge Datuk Wan Ahmad Farid Wan Salleh (now COA judge) ruled that MyCC's decision in announcing the proposed fine was filled with procedural impropriety and had breached natural justice.

"Hence, this court is allowing the certiorari application [to quash] the proposed decision. However, the court is not awarding the damages as there is no proof of mala fide [bad faith] by MyCC in making the proposed decision," Wan Ahmad Farid added.

Grab claimed it was never given the right to be heard in the Radzwan case, and so alleged no proper investigation took place for the proposed fine to be made, and the judge agreed.

"There was no evidence before me [the court] that MyCC had taken the investigative steps in the Radzwan complaint in the said manner that it had taken in [dealing with] the 2018 complaints," said Wan Ahmad Farid.

"One can be forgiven in concluding that there was no proper investigation made into the Radzwan complaint, only a proposed decision. I am therefore of the view that it is impossible for MyCC to make a fair proposed decision on the Radzwan complaint and holds that there is a prima facie case of infringement of Section 36(1) of the Competition Act 2010 (CA), when the applicant (Grab) was asked on the issue of the 2018 complaint during the investigation process [and not the Radzwan complaint]," the judge said.

Following the end of submissions on Monday, Nantha Balan fixed Tuesday as case management for it to fix a date to deliver its decision.
