Jualan Rahmah Mantai Aidilfitri lebih murah, meriah

MELAKA: Orang ramai dijemput untuk memanfaatkan peluang membeli barang keperluan Hari Raya Aidilfitri pada harga lebih murah di Jualan Rahmah Mantai Aidilfitri yang akan berlangsung di tapak parkir Masjid Jamek Laksamana Hang Tuah di sini, pada 29 Mac ini.

Menariknya, Dewari Undangan Negeri (DUN) Duyong dipilih sebagai lokasi utama bagi daerah Melaka Tengah, menjadikan jualan kali ini lebih besar dan meriah berbanding Jualan Rahmah biasa.

Menurut Ahli Dewari Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Duyong, Datuk Mohd. Noor Helmy Abdul Halem, program akan berlangsung dari pukul 8.30 pagi hingga

5 petang, menampilkan pelbagai barang asas pada harga istimewa.

"Orang ramai boleh mendapatkan pelbagai barang persiapan Aidilfitri seperti ayam, daging, beras, minyak masak peket dan banyak lagi dengan harga lebih rendah daripada pasaran.

"Ini adalah peluang terbaik bukan hanya untuk warga Duyong, tetapi seluruh rakyat Melaka," katanya kepada pemberita selepas Majlis Moreh Bersama Media yang diadakan di Kompleks Jawatankuasa Pembangunan dan Penyelarasian Dewan Undangan Negeri (Japerun) Duyong di sini, kelmarin.

Tambah Mohd. Noor Helmy,

Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kosa Sarawak (KPDN) telah memastikan bekalan barang mencukupi sepanjang program berlangsung.

"Pada jualan sebelum ini, satu vendor sahaja sudah mencatat nilai jualan sehingga RM60,000 dari pukul 8.30 pagi hingga 12 tengah hari tetapi kali ini, kita tempatkan empat vendor untuk memastikan bekalan mencukupi sepanjang program.

"Orang ramai dijangka membantahai program ini, namun kita nasihatkan supaya mereka merancang waktu kunjungan bagi mengelakkan kesesakan dan memastikan pengalaman membeli-belah yang lebih selesa," katanya.

KPDN steps up checks on controlled items during SHMMP

TAWAU: Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) enforcement officers will be deployed to strategic locations during the implementation of the Festive Season Maximum Price Scheme (SHMMP) for Hari Raya Puasa 2025.

Tawau KPDN Chief Enforcement Officer Sam Aminudin said identified locations include public markets, farmers' markets and supermarkets for inspection and enforcement operations.

This initiative aims to protect consumers from unethical traders during the 15-day SHMMP period, effective from March 24 to April 7.

Sam also urged public cooperation under the Kita Gempur mass movement campaign to report any violations of the scheme through WhatsApp at 019-848 8000, call centre at 1-800-886-800, email at e-aduan@kpdn.gov.my and Ez



ADU KPDN smartphone application.

The SHMMP covers seven days before the festival day itself and seven days after Hari Raya.

A total of 23 price-controlled items

have been listed in Sabah, namely meat and fish (imported buffalo meat, Demuduk, Sagai, Cermin or Cupak fish weighing between three to five fish per kilo, kembung/mabung fish weighing

between eight to 12 fish per kilo and selayang fish weighing between eight to 12 fish per kilo).

Vegetables include imported round cabbage (excluding Beijing cabbage), mustard greens, cucumber, tomato, red chili, long beans, carrots, large yellow onions, large imported red onions, small Indian red onions (Ros) and garlic (China).

Other items include imported potatoes (China), old imported ginger, peanuts, dried curly chili, whole coconut, grated coconut and coconut milk.

The scheme is enforced under the Price Control and Anti-Profitteering Act 2011, with maximum wholesale and retail prices available on www.kpdn.gov.my.

Individual traders who fail to comply can face up to RM100,000 or compounds of RM50,000, while companies can face fines up to RM500,000 or compounds up to RM250,000.

Additionally, Sam reminded traders to display pink price tags for controlled items and warned that strict action would be taken against violators.

In SANDAKAN, KPDN enforced the 2025 Festive Season Maximum Price Control Scheme here during the same period.

Sandakan KPDN District Chief Enforcement Officer Azdy Zukry John said the maximum price enforcement covers Sandakan, Kinabatangan, Beluran, Tongod and Telupid.

Traders are required to sell controlled-price items at or below the set maximum price.

"Retailers must display pink price tags on controlled-price items to distinguish them from other goods. Traders must also ensure adequate supply of goods in the market and use certified weighing and measuring equipment," he said.

Sufficient coconuts for Aidilfitri

KANGAR: The Perlis Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) has given an assurance of a sufficient coconut supply in the state for consumers throughout the Hari Raya Aidilfitri festive season.

Its Director, Rohaida Hassan said the issue of coconut supply in Perlis only arose in the first week of Ramadan, however, it has recovered after wholesalers in the state managed to obtain supplies from Indonesia apart from Sabah and Sarawak.

"Insya-Allah, there will be a supply of coconuts for this Raya, ensuring that the supply of santan (fresh coconut milk) will always be available at a price not exceeding RM20 per kilogramme. Currently, the price of santan is between RM17 and RM17.50 per kilogramme in Perlis, and we will monitor this price to ensure it does not rise to RM2," she said.

Rohaida said this to reporters after a walkabout session in conjunction with the implementation of the state-level Festive

Season Maximum Price Control Scheme (SHMMP) for Hari Raya Aidilfitri 2025 at Pasar Besar Sena here Wednesday.

She said santan is also among the 26 items listed under the implementation of the maximum price scheme, which is the maximum price at the retail level set at RM17.50 per kilogramme, effective March 24 to April 7.

Meanwhile, she said a total of 37 Perlis KPDN enforcement officers will monitor the price of goods from time to time during the festive season and consumers are urged to lodge complaints to them (Perlis KPDN) if traders do not follow the price scheme so that immediate action can be taken.

Regarding the walkabout, Rohaida said traders in Pasar Besar Sena were found to comply with the implementation of the pricing scheme as well as the price tags, and there were even traders there who sold goods at prices lower than the maximum prices set. – Bernama

Traders fined for breaching Raya price rules

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 1,751 premises across the country have been inspected by the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) during the first three days of the implementation of the Festive Season Maximum Price Scheme (SHMMP) for Hari Raya Aidilfitri, says its enforcement director-general Datuk Azman Adam.

Out of this, he said 119 forms of action were taken, including two cases involving traders selling goods above the set maximum prices.

"We have 2,400 officers nationwide and we are assisted by nearly 900 price monitors.

"Also, we receive a significant amount of information from the public, who report what's happening out there," he said yesterday.

"The SHMMP initiative aims to regulate the prices of essential goods during the festive season, ensuring fair pricing and preventing exploitation.

"Traders are advised to comply with the set price ceilings. Otherwise, strict action will be taken against offenders," he said in an interview, reported Bernama.

Under the scheme, 26 types of goods are placed under price control, an increase from 22 types last year.

The four newly-added items are small Indian red onions, carrots and coconut milk.

KPDN periksa 1,751 premis di seluruh negara

KUALA LUMPUR - Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak Hidup (KPDN) memeriksa sebanyak 1,751 premis perniagaan di seluruh negara selepas tiga hari pelaksanaan Skim Harga Maksimum Musim Perayaan (SHMMP) Hari Raya Puasa 2025.

Ketua Pengarah Penguat Kuasa KPDN, Datuk Azman Adam berkata, daripada jumlah itu, sebanyak 119 tindakan diambil termasuk dua kes melibatkan peniaga menjual melebihi harga ditetapkan.

"Di KPDN, kami ada 2,400 pegawai di seluruh negara dan turut dibantu hampir 900 pemantau harga termasuk mendapat banyak maklumat daripada orang ramai tentang apa berlaku di luar sana.

"Pegawai-pegawai ini akan terus

KPDN: 499 cases, RM3.3 mln in goods seized for PCAPA non-compliance

KUCHING: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Sarawak has to date recorded 499 cases of non-compliance with the Price Control and Anti-Profiteering Act 2011 (PCAPA), its director Matthew Dominic Barin disclosed.

He said these cases were detected following inspections at 40,377 premises during the SHMMP implementation period from Jan 1 to March 24 this year.

The inspections resulted in 499 cases recorded, involving estimated seizure value of over

RM3.3 million and compounds valued at RM83,000," he told a press conference after a walkabout to check the implementation of the Hari Raya Festive Season Maximum Price Scheme (SHMMP) at Everwin Samariang, here yesterday.

Matthew said under the PCAPA, offences constitute selling price-controlled price items above the ceiling price, and failing to place a pink price tag on these items.

Meanwhile, he encouraged consumers to take advantage of the Rahmah Madani Sale events.

"The Rahmah Sale event is

implemented in all 82 Sarawak state constituencies, two times a month on a rotation basis.

"Consumers can get a discount of up to 30 per cent for the purchase of eggs during the event," he said.

To a question on the retail prices of eggs in Sarawak following viral reports on social media that prices in the peninsula have dropped significantly, Matthew said the cheaper prices of eggs in Peninsular Malaysia could have been determined by the supplier.

"KPDN is more focused on law enforcement," he said.

Price control scheme a win-win scenario for consumers, traders — Hasidah

KUCHING: The Festive Season Maximum Price Control Scheme (SHMMP) creates a win-win situation for both consumers and the business community, said Datuk Sharifah Hasidah Sayeed Aman Ghazali.

In lauding the initiative by the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN), the Deputy Minister in the Sarawak Premier's Department said under SHMMP, consumers get to buy essential items at affordable prices.

"We want to make sure that during festive seasons, everybody wins — this is a win-win situation for both consumers and the traders," she said.

She said this when met during an inspection of the SHMMP implementation for Hari Raya at Everwin Centre Sdn Bhd in her Samariang constituency here yesterday.

"This is a caring government, we do not want the people to feel burdened when doing their festive shopping," she added.

Meanwhile, KPDN Sarawak director Matthew Dominic Barin said a total of 22 items have been gazetted under the Hari Raya SHMMP for Sarawak, effective March 24 to April 7.

The price-controlled items include imported buffalo meat;

ikan kembung and mabung (mackerels); ikan selayang; imported round cabbages (from Indonesia and China excluding Beijing cabbage); green mustards; cucumbers; tomatoes; red chillies; long beans; carrots; large yellow onions; imported red onions; Indian shallots; garlic from China; imported potatoes (China); imported old ginger; groundnuts; dried curly chillies; whole coconut (controlled at retail level only); grated coconut (controlled at retail level only);

and coconut milk (controlled at retail level only).

"The SHMMP will be enforced through the Price Control and Anti-Profitteering Act 2011 at the wholesale and retail levels," he said, adding that the public can visit the ministry's website at www.kpdn.gov.my for the gazetted prices.

Additionally, he said KPDN has deployed 188 enforcement officers and 92 price monitoring officers throughout Sarawak to monitor compliance and conduct

inspections in public markets, wet markets and supermarkets.

"The monitoring follows up on consumer complaints and aims to ensure that any non-compliance by traders is addressed in accordance with the legal provisions," he said.

KUCHING: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Sarawak akan mempertingkatkan keberadaan pegawai penguat kuasa dan pegawai pemantau harga di lokasi yang menjadi tumpuan pengguna.

Pengaruhnya Matthew Dominic Barin berkata, ia bagi mewujudkan persekitaran perniagaan dan beli-belah yang selamat serta beretika terutama semasa Skim Harga Maksimum Musim Perayaan (SHMMP) Hari Raya Puasa 2025 yang berkuat kuasa 24 Mac hingga 7 April 2025.

"KPDN Sarawak telah mengerakkan seramai 188 pegawai penguat kuasa dan 92 pegawai pemantau harga ke lokasi strategik seluruh Sarawak.

"Ia bagi memantau keberadaan bekalan dan pematuhan serta pemeriksaan di pasar awam, pasar tani dan pusat beli-belah.

"Pemeriksaan dijalankan bagi memantau ketidakpatuhan atau menyalasat aduan pengguna supaya mana-mana ketidakpatuhan oleh peniaga boleh diambil tindakan mengikut perundungan yang ditetapkan," ujarnya.

Barangan yang tersebarialah daging lembu import, ikan kembung termasuk ikan mambug, ikan selayang, kubis bulat import, sawi hijau, timun, tomato, cili merah, kacang panjang, lobak merah, bawang kuning besar, bawang merah besar import, bawang merah kecil India, bawang merah kecil India (ROS), bawang putih (China), ubi kentang import (China), halia tua import, kacang tanah, cili kering kerinting, kelapa biji (harga maksimum peringkat runcit sahaja), kelapa parut (harga maksimum peringkat runcit sahaja) dan santan (harga maksimum peringkat runcit sahaja).

Price scheme to benefit traders and consumers

KUCHING: The Sarawak government is implementing the Festive Season Maximum Price Scheme (SHMMP) to create mutual benefits between traders and consumers, especially in addressing economic challenges during festive seasons.

Deputy Minister in the Sarawak Premier's Department (Law, MA63 and Federal-State Relations), Datuk Sharifah Hasidah Sayeed Aman Ghazali said SHMMP is being implemented as a measure to control the prices of goods to prevent consumers from being burdened by high costs.

"We want everyone to benefit during the festive season, ensuring a win-win situation for all – whether for traders, consumers, or buyers. This is what we aim for during festive times.

"I hope all parties will comply with the regulations set by the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs (KPDN) for the collective good."

Sharifah Hasidah, who is also the Samariang assemblywoman, reminded supermarket traders to clearly display the prices of goods to ensure price transparency and prevent consumers from feeling deceived.

"We hope supermarket traders will display prices in pink," she added.

Sharifah Hasidah clarified that the supply of goods in Sarawak remains stable, and the authorities will continue to monitor the situation to ensure no supply shortages.

Additionally, she encouraged the public to take advantage of the Jualan Rahmah programme, which offers discounts of 10-30 per cent on weekends, especially on Saturdays and Sundays.

The programme is conducted in 80 State Assembly (DUN) constituencies across Sarawak, with 164 programmes held monthly, providing opportunities for the public to purchase goods at lower prices.

Bengkel simpan 5,000 liter diesel secara haram diserbu

IPOH – Sebuah bengkel kereta di Anjung Tawas Sinaran di sini, yang dijadikan stor haram bagi menyimpan 5,000 liter diesel tanpa permit diserbu Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KDPN) pada pukul 1.10 tengah hari kelmarin.

Pengarah KPDN Perak, Datuk Kamalludin Ismail berkata, serbuhan dilakukan hasil maklumat risikan dan pemantauan selama seminggu oleh pihaknya ke atas aktiviti membanteras penyelewengan dan ketirisan barang kawalan di kawasan Ipoh.

Katanya, maklumat sumber risikan telah berjaya mengesan tempat simpanan stor haram minyak diesel berselindung di sebalik bengkel kereta.

"Modus operandi sindiket adalah membeli minyak diesel pada harga murah sekitar RM2 seliter daripada pemandu-pemandu lori syarikat yang menurunnya dari kenderaan tersebut.

"Pemandu berkenaan menyedut minyak diesel dari tangki asal lori ke dalam tong di belakang bengkel. Minyak diesel tersebut akan dijual kepada pihak industri di sekitar Ipoh," katanya di sini semalam.

Beliau berkata, ketika pemeriksaan dilakukan pasukan serbuhan telah menjumpai

sebanyak 5,000 liter cecair yang disyaki minyak diesel di premis tersebut.

Katanya, seorang lelaki tempatan berumur 59 tahun yang mengaku sebagai pemilik bengkel didapati gagal mengemukakan sebarang surat kebenaran, lesen atau permit menyimpan barang kawalan itu.

"Sehubungan itu, satu tinjakan kes diambil dengan menyita cecair disyaki minyak diesel sebanyak 5,000 liter, 24 tong dram, 11 tong jerrycan, alat mengepam minyak dan telefon bimbit dengan nilai rampasan keseluruhan dianggarkan berjumlah RM19,363.94," katanya.

Kamalludin berkata, kes disiasat di bawah Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 kerana disyaki melakukan kesalahan memiliki atau menyimpan barang kawalan berjadual minyak diesel tanpa kebenaran.

Beliau berkata, siasatan lanjut juga akan dilaksanakan di bawah Peraturan 9 (2)(b) Peraturan-Peraturan Kawalan Bekalan 1974 ke atas syarikat pembekal barang kawalan minyak diesel itu.

Katanya, ini kerana syarikat tersebut disyaki telah menjual atau membekalkan barang kawalan kepada orang yang tidak mempunyai lesen atau permit barang kawalan.

半數商品比統制價低

KPDN：文良港巨人霸市成榜樣

（吉隆坡26日讯）国内贸易及生活消费部（KPDN）联邦直辖区吉隆坡分局总监莫哈末沙比利表示，文良港巨人霸市有超过半数商品售价低于政府设定的2025年开斋节统制品顶价计划（SHMMP）的价格，其中有些商品价格更比统制品价格低逾50%。

他呼吁其他商家，要以文良港巨人霸市为榜样。

他补充，上述计划于3月24日正式开跑，26种受控商品比去年增加4种，分别为印度小红葱、印度玫瑰小红葱、红萝卜和椰浆，以帮助民众应对节日期间的需求。,

配合为期15天的开斋节顶价计划，莫哈末沙比利在昨天与执法人员到文良港巨人霸市进行市场巡视后，这么表示。

他说，有关计划将确保节日期间的物价稳定，并且减轻人民的生活成本。除了保障消费者的利益之外，同时亦可达到维持商家的合理利润。

“希望商家能够在获得较低成本的情况下，提供类似的优惠价格。我们并没有强迫商家去卖1令吉、2令吉的商品，但如果商家能降低成本，就应

该降低价格。”

须严守价格规定

另外，他强调，商家必须在统制品上，张贴粉色标签以表明该价格，否则个人将被法庭罚款1万令吉，或被开5000令吉罚单；公司则被法庭罚款高达2万令吉，或被开出1万令吉罚单。

同时，以超过顶价售卖统制品的个人商家将被法庭罚款高达10万令吉、或被监禁不超过3年、或两者兼施；亦可被开出高达5万令吉的罚单；公司则将被法庭罚款最高50万令吉，或被开出高达25万令吉的罚单。

他呼吁民众合作，若发现有商家违规时，可通过WhatsApp (019-848 8000)、内贸局网站 (<http://eaduan.kpdn.gov.my>)、热线中心(1-800-886-800)或 Ez ADU KPDN手机应用程序进行投诉。

Bersyukur dengan perkembangan itu, Presiden 3P Muzik Malaysia, Aris Ariwatan, berkata selepas mengkaji dengan teliti, garis panduan itu dilihat dapat memperbaiki tatakelola, ketelusan dan

tanggungjawab setiap organisasi pengurusan kolektif.

Organisasi pengurusan kolektif adalah badan yang diberi mandat oleh ahlinya, laiat pemegang hak harta intelek untuk memungut dan mengagihkan kutipan royalti.

“MyIPO pengawal hak cipta Malaysia, dengan jelas berjaya memahami permasalahan dan ketidakadilan dihadapi ahli di setiap peringkat penggiat muzik tanah

air apabila membabitkan organisasi kolektif.

“Kefahaman MyIPO pasti terhasil daripada beberapa siri bengkel, seminar, dialog dan pertemuan dengan penggiat muzik di peringkat akar umbi, malah dengan wakil organisasi pengurusan kolektif.

“Sesi itu sudah berlangsung bersama bekas Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak Hidup, Allahyarham Datuk Seri

Salahuddin Ayub, kemudian diperbaiki dan dilaksanakan di bawah kepimpinan menteri berikutnya, Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Perkasa penggiat muzik

Aris yang juga penyanyi popular era 1990-an, berkata proses menghasilkan garis panduan pastinya melalui usaha wajar yang bukan sahaja adil, malah akan melindungi dan memperkasakan penggiat muzik tanah air.

Katanya, penggiat muzik berkenaan adalah mereka yang sama ada mempunyai nama besar atau ribuan penggiat semi yang kerdil namanya, namun menyara hidup dengan kerja seni muzik.

“Lebih penting lagi, garis panduan MyIPO ini dapat mengharmonikan hubungan antara penggiat muzik dengan persatuan pengguna karya muzik di Malaysia.

“Hubungan simbolik antara pengguna karya muzik dengan

penggiat muzik seperti aur dengan tebing, saling memerlukan. Organisasi pengurusan kolektif yang benar-benar profesional adalah penghubung antara kami,” katanya.

Pada masa sama, Aris berkata, pengguna karya muzik menjadi punca pendapatan penggiat muzik dan setiap karya muzik adalah keperluan pengguna, justeru kedua-duanya perlu saling meraihan.

“Barulah ia menjadi alunan muzik harmoni,” katanya menambah garis panduan hak cipta dikeluarkan MyIPO itu amat diperlukan dan dialu-alukan demi penambahbaikan tatakelola, ketelusan dan tanggungjawab organisasi pengurusan kolektif.

“Kami penggiat muzik menjadi ahli yang tiada suara. Seksyen 27M dalam Akta Hak Cipta Malaysia adalah punca kuasa yang ada pada MyIPO untuk menguatkuasakan garis panduan akta hak cipta demi keadilan dan keharmonian buat semua,” katanya.

Harga barang asas terkawal menjelang sambutan Aidilfitri

Langkah KPDN, KPKM tunjuk petanda positif hasil usaha Kerajaan MADANI

Putrajaya: Harga barang asas adalah terkawal menjelang sambutan Aidilfitri susulan langkah dilaksanakan Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak (KPDN) serta Kementerian Pertanian dan Keterjaminan Makanan (KPKM).

Jurucakap Kerajaan Perpaduan, Datuk Fahmi Fadzil, berkata keadaan itu menunjukkan petanda positif hasil usaha Kerajaan MADANI.

"Mesyuarat Jemaah Menteri pada hari ini (semalam) dimulakan dengan ucapan tahniah Perdana Menteri (Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim) kepada KPDN dan KPKM, atas kejayaan memastikan perkara berkaitan pengawalan harga barang asas, terutama menjelang sambutan Aidilfitri adalah terkawal.

"Kita juga melihat ada peranan diimankan oleh pemain industri yang memberi kerjasama kepada KPDN serta KPKM (dalam memastikan harga barang asas

terkawal)," katanya pada sidang media pascamesyuarat Kabinet, di sini, semalam.

Fahmi yang juga Menteri Komunikasi berkata, selain harga barang asas terkawal, bekalan beras putih tempatan pula sudah mula diagharkan ke pelbagai lokasi.

Katanya, KPKM kini sedang giat secara berterusan untuk mengenal pasti lokasi yang masih belum memperoleh bekalan terbabit.

"Malah ada dalam kalangan menteri yang menyatakan di sesetengah tempat harga telur pun turun menjelang Aidilfitri.

"Jadi ini adalah petanda yang agak positif untuk orang ramai," katanya.

Manfaat 'Price Catcher'

Justeru, Fahmi menyarankan orang ramai supaya memanfaatkan aplikasi *Price Catcher* untuk mengenal pasti lokasi yang menjual produk serta barang asas pada harga berpatutan.

"Kita boleh buat perbandingan harga bagi premis yang berbeza, produk sama. Jadi manfaatkan aplikasi ini," katanya.

Sementara itu, Fahmi berkata, Perdana Menteri menyatakan kepada Jemaah Menteri bahawa Bantuan Khas Kewangan (BKK) 2025 berjumlah RM500, termasuk kenaikan gaji melalui Sistem Sarana Perkhidmatan Awam (SSPA) dinikmati penjawat awam sebanyak RM500 bagi Gred 56 ke ba-

katanya, walaupun membabitkan jumlah yang besar, perkara itu berjaya dilaksanakan Kerajanan MADANI.

"Baru-baru ini, Perdana Menteri juga mengumumkan BKK Aidilfitri buat pejabat awam sebanyak RM500 bagi Gred 56 ke ba-

wah dan RM250 kepada semua pesara kerajaan, termasuk veteren berpencen serta tidak berpencen dan juga guru Kelas al-Quran dan Farud Ain (KAFA) dan BKK Aidilfitri berjumlah RM500 kepada 14,000 penjawat awam di Terengganu."

"Ini antara usaha kerajaan untuk memastikan rakyat terus menerima bantuan dan insya-Allah kita harap ia akan menceriakan, terutama menjelang Aidilfitri bagi rakyat Malaysia, terutama dalam kalangan penjawat awam," katanya.

5GB data percuma sempena raya pertama

PUTRAJAYA - Semua rakyat Malaysia bakal menikmati tambahan kuota data minimum lima gigabit (GB) pada Hari Raya Aidilfitri pertama.

Jurucakap Kerajaan, Datuk Fahmi Fadzil berkata, ia berikutan kerajaan menerusi Kementerian Komunikasi melaksanakan pemberian Insentif Rebat Rahmah dengan kerjasama strategik penyedia perkhidmatan telekomunikasi.

"Tambahkan kuota data itu sah bagi tempoh minimum 24 jam, terakluk kepada terma dan syarat penawaran syarikat penyedia perkhidmatan telekomunikasi yang terlibat," katanya menerusi sidang akhbar mingguan pasca Kabinet di sini pada Rabu.

Ujarnya, syarikat yang terlibat adalah

CelcomDigi, Maxis, U Mobile, TM Tech, YTL Communications, Pavo Comms, Tune Talk, redONE, REDtone dan XOX Com.

"Pemberian insentif bersempena hari raya ini diharap dapat membantu mengeratkan silaturahim terutama menerusi komunikasi dalam talian di samping memeriahkan sambutan Aidilfitri," jelas Fahmi.

Ditanya jumlah kos bagi pelaksanaan insentif berkenaan, Fahmi berkata, Insentif Rebat Rahmah yang kali pertama diusahakan Kementerian Komunikasi itu ditanggung sepenuhnya oleh semua penyedia perkhidmatan telekomunikasi terbabit.

"Tak... subsidi dan ia (insentif) bukan ditanggung kerajaan," katanya sambil me-

nambah jumlah akaun telekomunikasi yang berdaftar di Malaysia ialah sekitar 45 juta.

Maklumat lanjut mengenai Insentif Rebat Rahmah Aidilfitri itu akan diumumkan oleh syarikat penyedia perkhidmatan telekomunikasi.

Dalam pada itu, Fahmi berkata, Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim mengucapkan tahniah kepada Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak (KPDN) dan Kementerian Pertanian dan Keterjaminan Makanan (KPKM) di atas kejayaan memastikan perkara berkaitan pengawalan harga barang asas, terutama sepanjang tempoh menjelang Aidilfitri terkawal.

Prices of basic items under control ahead of Aidilfitri — Fahmi

PUTRAJAYA: The prices of basic items ahead of the Hari Raya Aidilfitri celebrations are under control following efforts taken by the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) and the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security (KPKM), said Communications Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil.

Fahmi, who is also the MADANI Government spokesman, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim congratulated the KPDN and KPKM at the Cabinet meeting today for their success in ensuring the prices of basic goods are kept under control, especially ahead of the Aidilfitri celebrations.

Fahmi said that industry players also helped ensure the prices of goods continue to be under control by giving their cooperation to the KPDN and KPKM.

"We can also see that local white rice (BPT) has begun to reach various locations and the KPKM is continuously striving to identify the places that have yet to obtain the BPT and to deliver it.

"Some of the ministers have also said that the prices of eggs at certain places have come down ahead of Hari Raya Aidilfitri. So, this is quite a positive sign," he told a media conference here Wednesday.

Fahmi also urged the public to make use of the PriceCatcher application to identify the locations selling basic items at reasonable prices, in addition to making price comparisons at premises which sell similar products.

Meanwhile, Fahmi said the Prime Minister also explained to the Cabinet Ministers that the 2025 Special Financial Aid (BKK) of RM500, including the salary increase through the Public Service Remuneration System (SSPA) that is enjoyed by civil servants, involved a significant amount and was successfully implemented by the MADANI Government.

Fahmi added that last December, the salary of civil servants who signed the SSPA increased by an average of eight per cent for the first phase while the second phase will be implemented at the end of this year for a second increase. — Bernama

231kg Ramadan food saved

business e-wallet," he said.
