Syarikat minyak perlu salur maklumat tepat



Usaha permudah urusan pengguna ketika program dilaksanakan

Putrajaya: Kementerian Komunikasi bekerjasama dengan Kementerian Kewangan (MoF) serta Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) bagi memastikan syarikat minyak di seluruh negara menyalurkan maklumat tepat mengenai pelaksanaan inisiatif BUDI MADANI (BUDI95) kepada pelanggan di stesen minyak.

Menteri Komunikasi, Datuk Fahmi Fadzil, berkata langkah itu penting bagi memastikan

orang ramai mudah mendapatkan maklumat yang sahih terutama apabila mereka mengunjungi stesen minyak pada tarikh pelaksanaan program itu.

“Saya juga telah minta pihak MoF menjemput sekiranya ada TikTokers, laman sesawang, pengengaruh dan sebagainya, yang mungkin ingin tahu maklumat lebih tepat, ke satu sesi penerangan dan penjelasan termasuk rakan dalam Kerajaan Perpaduan, supaya semua pihak faham.”

“Kita juga memastikan maklumat yang tepat mengenai isu dibangkitkan sampai kepada khalayak umum melalui media massa dan media sosial... jadi, ini antara yang diusahakan Kementerian Komunikasi,” katanya pada Majlis Perhimpunan Bulanan Kementerian Komunikasi di sini semalam.

Yang turut hadir, Timbalan Menteri Komunikasi Teo Nie Ching; Ketua Setiausaha Kementerian Komunikasi, Datuk Seri Mohamad Fauzi Md Isa dan Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Pertubuhan Berita Nasional Malaysia (BERNAMA), Datin Paduka Nur-ul Afida Kamaludin.

Fahmi berkata, agensi seperti Jabatan Penerangan dan Jabatan Komunikasi Komuniti (J-KOM) juga diminta meneliti dan memahami soalan lazim (FAQ) yang disediakan MoF di laman sesawang www.budi95.gov.my bagi memudahkan penerangan tepat disampaikan kepada rakyat.

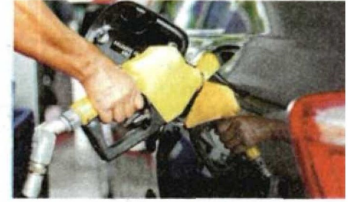
bila mengunjungi stesen minyak pada tarikh pelaksanaan program tersebut.

Ministries collaborate to ensure dissemination of accurate information on fuel subsidy

PUTRAJAYA: The Communications Ministry is working closely with the Finance Ministry and the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry to ensure that oil companies nationwide provide accurate information on the implementation of Budi95 to customers at their petrol stations.

Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil said this is important to make it easy for the general public to access verified information at the petrol stations when the subsidy programme officially rolls out.

"I have also requested the Finance Ministry to invite TikTok users, influencers, website operators and others interested in obtaining accurate information to attend a briefing session. This includes our partners within the Unity government to ensure everyone

is well-informed.

"We are also committed to delivering accurate information regarding any concerns raised to the general public through mass media and social media channels. This is part of the ministry's ongoing efforts," he said at the Communications Ministry's monthly assembly yesterday.

Also present were Deputy Minister Teo Nie Ching and secretary-general Datuk Seri Mohamad Fauzi Md Isa, as well as Bernama CEO Datin Paduka Nurul Afida Kamaludin.

Fahmi further explained that agencies such as the Information Department and the Community Communications Department have been tasked with reviewing and understanding the frequently asked questions (FAQ) prepared by the Finance

Ministry, available on the official portal www.budi95.gov.my.

"I have also asked the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission team to notify all National Information Dissemination Centre managers to thoroughly study the FAQ.

"The government wants to ensure that only Malaysian citizens benefit from the initiative."

He added that questions regarding data use, the reason for using Touch 'n Go as the server and other concerns are all addressed in the FAQ, which spans over 36 pages.

Last Monday, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim announced a reduction in the price of RON95 petrol to RM1.99 per litre from RM2.05 per litre under Budi95. – Bernama

'Social media must adopt eKYC'

PUTRAJAYA: All social media platform providers operating in Malaysia have been advised to implement electronic Know-Your-Customer (eKYC) verification using government-issued documents such as MyKad, a passport or MyDigital ID.

Communications Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil said the implementation of the electronic identity system would ensure that user identities are fully verified to reduce online fraud and prevent children under 13 from opening their own social media accounts.

"For now, we are encouraging it, but when the Online Safety Act comes into effect at the end of this year or early next year, it will become mandatory."

"We found that platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp, Telegram, TikTok and others do not yet have a truly capable eKYC system, so we have asked them to implement the

eKYC process using official government-issued documents," he said at the ministry's monthly assembly, Bernama reported.

Fahmi said the government is firm in ensuring Malaysians are protected from online crimes such as investment scams, gambling and the sale of prohibited goods.

The ministry, through the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), will coordinate a meeting of the police, the Attorney General's Chambers, the National Anti-Financial Crime Centre and the Finance Ministry (MOF), with Meta and TikTok in Singapore within the next two weeks.

Among the issues to be raised are the sale of prohibited items such as drug-laced vape liquids on Meta platforms and the implementation of eKYC verification.

On another matter, Fahmi said his ministry is working with the MOF and the Domestic Trade and

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Cost of Living Ministry to ensure that oil companies nationwide provide accurate information about the implementation of the Budi Madani (Budi95) initiative to customers at their petrol stations.

Fahmi said the effort is important to make it easy for the public to access verified information at the petrol stations when the subsidy programme rolls out on Sept 30.

"I have also requested that the MOF invite TikTokers, websites, influencers and others interested in obtaining accurate information to attend a briefing session. This includes our partners within the unity government to ensure everyone is well informed."

KUALA LUMPUR: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN), in collaboration with TikTok Shop and several government agencies, has helped 2,500 micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) generate over RM300 million in sales through targeted programmes since June 2024.

Deputy Minister Senator Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh said the close cooperation between KPDN, the Ministry of Entrepreneur Development and Cooperatives, and TikTok Shop – particularly in providing access to digital marketing technology, logistical support and interactive promotional campaigns – has strengthened the competitiveness of MSMEs.

Fuziah emphasised that supporting local products represents identity, dignity, and national pride.

"Every time we buy Malaysian products, we are supporting an entrepreneur's dream, sustaining a family and contributing to the nation's economic growth," she said.

She also highlighted success stories of small home-based businesses that have grown to sell thousands of units monthly through livestreaming.

Prominent content creators, she noted, have also uplifted communities.

"For example, Khairul Aming has used his influence to mobilise flood relief missions, while Pinn Yang has harnessed digital creativity to promote positive values within society," she added.

Fuziah further stressed the importance of transparency, ethical business practices, consumer protection and self-regulation in building a more resilient e-commerce ecosystem.

"With more than 1.7 million local sellers and 3 million active content creators on TikTok Shop Malaysia, Pesta Jom Lokal 2025 is expected to make a significant impact in empowering local entrepreneurs, enhancing the competitiveness of Malaysian products and positioning KBBM as a true people's movement."

She added KPDN remains committed to ensuring these efforts directly benefit the people, while building a safe, transparent, ethical and sustainable digital ecosystem for Malaysia.

Pesta Jom Lokal 2025 memaparkan tema 'Merancakkan Ekonomi Usahawan Malaysia'

KUALA LUMPUR: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN), dengan kerjasama TikTok Shop serta beberapa agensi kerajaan, telah berjaya membantu 2,500 perusahaan mikro, kecil dan sederhana (PMKS) menjana lebih RM300 juta hasil jualan melalui program kerjasama bersasar sejak Jun 2024.

Timbalan Menteri KPDN, Senator Datuk Dr. Fuziah Salleh, berkata kerjasama rapat antara KPDN, Kementerian Pembangunan Usahawan dan Koperasi (KUSKOP) serta TikTok Shop khususnya dalam menyediakan akses kepada teknologi pemasaran digital, sokongan logistik dan kempen promosi interaktif telah memperkukuh daya saing PMKS.

(KBBM), pesta ini menghimpunkan lebih 800 peserta, termasuklah PMKS, penjual berskala sederhana, pencipta kandungan digital serta agensi kerajaan berkaitan bagi memperkukuh ekosistem e-dagang negara.

Fuziah menegaskan bahawa menyokong produk tempatan melambangkan identiti, maruah dan kebanggaan nasional.

"Setiap kali kita membeli produk Malaysia, kita sebenarnya sedang menyokong impian seorang usahawan, menjamin kelangsungan sebuah keluarga serta menyumbang kepada pertumbuhan ekonomi negara," jelasnya.

Beliau turut menekankan kisah-kisah kejayaan yang mampu memberi inspirasi, seperti perniagaan kecil berasaskan rumah yang berkembang sehingga mampu menjual ribuan unit setiap bulan melalui penstriman langsung.

"Sebagai contoh, Khairul Aming menggunakan pengaruhnya untuk menggerakkan misi bantuan banjir, manakala Pinn Yang memanfaatkan kreativiti digital bagi mempromosikan nilai-nilai positif dalam masyarakat," tambahnya.

Timbalan Menteri itu turut menegaskan kepentingan ketelusan, amalan perniagaan beretika, perlindungan pengguna dan kawal selia sendiri sebagai amalan terbaik untuk membina ekosistem e-dagang yang lebih berdaya tahan.
