Beli minyak masak peket, petrol RON95 perlu imbas kod QR – Fuziah

KUALA LUMPUR - Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) sedang membangunkan sistem kawalan bagi menangani isu ketirisan minyak masak peket bersubsidi termasuk pembelian oleh warga asing.

Timbalan Menteri, Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh berkata, sistem tersebut kini dalam fasa ujian sebelum dilaksanakan secara menyeluruh di seluruh negara.

"Kita sedar apa yang dikuatiri

adalah warga asing mendapat akses kepada barang kawalan seperti minyak masak, gula, petrol dan banyak lagi. Setiap satu barang kawalan ini ada masalah unik masing-masing, tetapi setakat ini bekalan gula mencukupi jadi ia tak terlalu menjadi isu.

"Namun untuk minyak masak peket, ia jadi isu kepada rakyat Malaysia kerana mereka susah nak akses apabila warga asing yang membelinya.

"Jadi apa KPDN sedang lakukan adalah membangunkan aplikasi

Sistem Skim Penstabilan Harga Minyak Masak (eCOSS) merangkumi semua rantaian termasuk pemborong, peruncit hingga kepada pengguna," katanya ketika mengulung perbahasan Rancangan Malaysia Ke-13 (RMK13) mewakili KPDN di Dewan Negara pada Rabu.

Menurut Fuziah, pengguna mesti mengimbas kod QR dan hanya dibenar membuat pembelian apabila disahkan warganegara.

Katanya, aplikasi sama akan turut

digunakan bagi pembelian petrol.

"Insya-ALLAH tak lama lagi bagi pembelian RON95, akan guna pendekatan sama iaitu mesti ada semakan kad pengenalan di stesen minyak.

"Ini perancangan kita akan datang dalam usaha melindungi barang kawalan subsidi supaya tak mengalir kepada warga asing dengan setiap satu daripadanya (barang kawalan) ini ada strategi (pelaksanaan) berbeza," ujar beliau.

'Tiada kekurangan bekalan barangan keperluan asas'

PUTRAJAYA – Kerajaan menjelaskan tiada sebarang kekurangan bekalan barangan keperluan asas susulan pelaksanaan Sumbangan Asas Rahmah (SARA) Untuk Semua bermula 31 Ogos lalu.

Jurucakap Kerajaan, Datuk Fahmi Fadzil berkata, perkara itu dibincangkan dalam Mesyuarat Jemaah Menteri yang dipengerusikan Timbalan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi.

Jelas beliau, Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) bersama Kementerian Pertanian dan Keterjaminan Makanan sentiasa memantau keadaan bagi memastikan bekalan kekal stabil.

“Setakat ini, KPDN tidak melaporkan sebarang masalah dari segi stok. Pemantauan akan terus dipertingkatkan bagi memastikan tiada gangguan terhadap bekalan barangan keperluan,” katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian menerusi sidang akhbar mingguan pasca mesyuarat Kabinet di sini pada Rabu.

Menurutnya, kerajaan mahu mengelakkan berlakunya panik atau pembelian panik dalam kalangan pengguna kerana kredit RM100 yang diberikan kepada 22 juta rakyat berusia 18 tahun itu boleh ditebus sehingga 31 Disember depan.

Sebelum ini, Kementerian Kewangan (MoF) memaklumkan lebih 2.9 juta orang telah membeli barangan keperluan asas menggunakan kredit SARA dalam tempoh tiga hari, dengan jumlah perbelanjaan rakyat mencecah RM192.4 juta di seluruh negara.

MINISTRY WARNS PROFITEERS

Fuziah says monitoring, enforcement will be intensified to protect consumers

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THE Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry has vowed firm action against profiteering, warning traders that strict monitoring and enforcement will be intensified to protect consumers.

The assurance came from its deputy minister, Datuk Fuziah Salleh, in response to a viral claim on Facebook alleging that a hypermarket was selling a 5kg pack of rice for RM55, compared with RM35 elsewhere.

Checks by a ministry officer sent to the hypermarket confirmed the post was based on a misunderstanding between the prices of 2kg and 5kg packs.

"The ministry is committed to safeguarding consumers' interests and ensuring supply and prices remain stable.

"At the same time, we urge the public to verify information before sharing it, as false or misleading claims can cause panic and distrust," she told the *New Straits Times* yesterday.

She warned that individuals found guilty of profiteering face fines of up to RM100,000 or three years' imprisonment, or both, while companies could be fined up to RM500,000.

"The ministry will not hesitate to take strict action against any party found exploiting consumers," she said.

Consumers are urged to report suspected profiteering through the Enforcement Command Centre (03-8882 6245/6088), WhatsApp, the e-Complaint Portal, the Ez ADU KPDN mobile app, or the ministry's call centre at 1-800-886-800.

In Putrajaya, unity government spokesman Datuk Fahmi Fadzil said there were no shortages of essential goods despite concerns over high demand following the rollout of the one-off RM100 Sumbangan Asas Rahmah (Sara) aid programme.

Fahmi, who is also communications minister, said the matter was discussed in the weekly cabinet meeting, which also reviewed the early implementation of the programme.

He added that the ministry and the Agriculture and Food Security Ministry were monitoring the situation to ensure supplies were stable.

"Increased monitoring will continue to make sure there are no disruptions to the supply of essential goods," he said.

Fahmi added that the government wanted to prevent unnecessary panic or hoarding among consumers, adding that the RM100 credit given to 22 million Malaysians under the Sara scheme was intended to ease household spending on daily necessities.

The RM100 credit, channelled through recipients' MyKad, can be redeemed at more than 7,300 participating premises nationwide until Dec 31.

Fahmi said the Cabinet also took note of problems faced by supermarkets when recipients abandoned goods during system downtime on the first days of the programme.

"To address this, the ministry and the Finance Ministry will advise participating premises on better ways to manage such situations," he said. **Additional reporting by Luqman Hakim**

'Marry a local' tactic used by foreigners to conduct business legally

KUALA LUMPUR: Marrying locals has been identified as the main modus operandi used by foreigners to conduct business legally in the country, the Dewan Negara was told yesterday.

Deputy Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh said this was because the Registration of Businesses Act 1956 (Act 197) only permits Malaysian citizens

and permanent residents to register sole proprietorships or partnerships.

"However, there are foreigners who take advantage by registering businesses under the names of their local spouses.

"Perhaps we can discuss how this poses a threat to other (local) traders," she said when winding up the debate on the

13th Malaysia Plan motion for the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN).

Fuziah said the ministry often received complaints from local traders who felt threatened by the situation, but explained that the business registrations were legally carried out by their local spouses.

She added that the registration of businesses such as retail

shops under Act 197 is limited to Malaysian citizens or permanent residents as a measure to protect local small and medium enterprises from foreign competition.

"To date, the Companies Commission of Malaysia does not have any regulation barring individuals married to foreigners from registering a business," she said.—Bernama

Foreigners with 13,000kg LPG cylinders jailed for 15 months

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JOHOR BARU: Five Indonesian men have been sentenced to 15 months in jail for having over 13,000kg of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) cylinders.

Muhammad Ali, 32; Zulfan Fauzi, 31; Nasrullah, 34; Marhaban, 31; and Adnan, 28, pleaded guilty to the charges in the Sessions Court yesterday.

They admitted having 13,746kg of LPG cylinders, a controlled item under Regulation 3(1) of the Control of Supplies Regulations 1974, without a licence.

The offence was allegedly committed at Jalan Sungai Tiram, Ulu Tiram, at about 7.05pm on July 28.

They were charged under Section 21 of the Control of Supplies Act 1961 (Act 122), which carries a fine of up to RM1mil or imprisonment of up to three years, or both, upon conviction.

When asking for a lighter sentence, the accused told the court that they were merely workers.

Adnan said he had just arrived and had yet to start his job while Marhaban said he had only been working for seven days when they were arrested.

Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry prosecuting officer S. Loganathan urged the court to impose a heavier sentence, stressing that the offence had significant effects on the public and caused great losses to the country.

He also asked the court to forfeit the ownership of the seized items, including two trailers, for them to be handed over to the government.

Sessions judge Thalha Bachok @ Embok Mok sentenced the men to 15 months' jail from the date of arrest and ordered the forfeiture of the seized goods.

On July 28, enforcement officers uncovered an illegal LPG storage facility at a warehouse in Ulu Tiram during an operation.

The operation, which was jointly carried out by enforcement teams from Putrajaya and Johor, led to 1,357 LPG cylinders worth an estimated RM280,000 being seized, as well as the arrest of the accused persons.

They were charged on Aug 1.

Fahmi: No reports on shortages of essential items

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PUTRAJAYA: There have been no reports on shortages of essential goods under the Sumbangan Asas Rahmah (Sara) one-off RM100 credit redemption, says Communications Minister Datuk Fahmi Fadzil (*pic*).

He said that although the issue was not raised during the Cabinet meeting yesterday, the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry and the Agriculture and Food Security Ministry will continue monitoring to ensure supplies, including eggs and chicken, are sufficient.



He said RM192.5mil had already been redeemed through the Sara credits.

The government spokesperson also defended the decision to channel the aid via MyKad instead of cash, stressing that it was meant strictly for the purchase of essential goods.

"There was criticism from the public and some MPs over this, but the Sara programme is aimed at providing basic necessities and addressing cost-of-living issues.

"The RM100 credit must be used for household items, and the mechanism ensures this purpose is met," he said.

Fahmi rejected claims that the initiative had racial elements, as alleged by certain parties, pointing out that over 7,300 outlets – including hypermarkets, bumiputra-owned shops and international supermarkets – are participating.

On reports of shoppers abandoning items at counters due to system glitches, Fahmi said the Finance Ministry and Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry would advise participating outlets on managing such disruptions.

法米：滿足SARA需求 確保必需品庫存充足

（布城3日讯）通讯部长拿督法米指出，政府将加强监督确保基本必需品的库存充足，以满足人民兑换特别回馈爱心基本援助金（SARA）的需求。

他今日在内阁会议后的记者会上指出，国内贸易及生活成本部告知，截至目前，市场上的相关物品存货充足。

“内贸部并没有通报任何与供应相关的问题，并且还会加强监督，以确保基本必需品的库存或供应不会出现问题。”

自8月31日起，政府通过大马卡向所有18岁及以上的大马公民发放一次性的100令吉SARA援金，并可在全国超过7000个营业场所兑换，直至2025年12月31日。

这项援助惠及2200万人，总拨款达20亿令吉。

兼任昌明政府发言人的法米指出，由副首相拿督斯里阿末扎希主持的内阁会议也获悉，截至周三凌晨，已有

1亿9240万令吉的SARA援金通过购买基本必需品完成兑换。

“第二财长拿督斯里阿米尔韩查也通报，财政部将建议超过7000间的营业场所，提醒顾客在兑换SARA援金之前，先检查一些事项。”

法米也驳斥部分人士质疑使用大马卡兑换SARA援金所抛出的指控，并强调这项机制旨在确保援金专用于购买基本必需品。

“这笔100令吉是为了帮助家庭购买生活必需品，所以这项机制是旨在确保所分配的资金达到其目的，并符合该计划的初衷。”

询及在使用大马卡时系统出现故障，导致部分民众将物品遗留在柜台一事，法米呼吁人民无需急于消费这笔援金，因为兑换期限是直到今年12月31日。

“所以时间还很充裕，我们可以合理安排，选择人流较少的时段，然后前往任何邻近的商店。”（TTK）
