CONCERN OVER OIL, EGG SHORTAGE

Consumers want ministry to resolve low stock of polybag cooking oil and eggs in trays of 30

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SUBSIDISED cooking oil in polybags were sold out at several supermarkets in the district here yesterday.

However, there were still many stocks of bottled cooking oil of between 2kg and 5kg.

Checks found that polybag cooking oil, which were being rationed at three packets per customer, were sold out.

Several consumers had raised their concern over the matter and

urged the government to address the short supply of subsidised cooking oil.

Housewife Jamaliah Kamarudin, 56, said the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry should act quickly to overcome the shortage of the essential item.

"Not everyone can afford bottled cooking oil, especially the underprivileged.

"The problem of shortage of subsidised cooking oil needs to be solved immediately," she said.

A survey on the supply of chicken

eggs also found a similar situation, especially for trays of 30 eggs.

The omega-10 enriched and other premium chicken eggs were still available in retail stores, but were costlier.

Nasi lemak seller, Junaidi Kamaruzzaman, 45, said the difficulty in getting regular eggs had affected his business.

He said he had to source for supplies from several supermarkets and grocery shops, he said.

"I hope the government will immediately restore the supply of chicken eggs," he said.

STEEP INCREASE

Builders want solution to cement price hike

JOHOR BARU: Builders associations want the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry to investigate the steep rise in concrete and cement prices since November 2020.

The Johor Builders Association, Melaka Builders Association, Perak Contractors Association and Penang Builders Association in a joint statement said they hoped that the issue would get the attention of the ministry and be resolved quickly.

"We also want to make an appeal to the ministry to do a review, whether there is any party that may have violated the Competition Act, which prohibits anti-competitive agreements and abuse of dominant position in the market during the implementation of these price increases," they said yesterday.

According to the statement, the prices of concrete and cement had gone up by 15 per cent last month, after a 15 per cent increase in March.

The associations said this had put the entire construction industry under severe pressure.

"However, we hope that all parties in the construction industry can continue to persevere in this difficult business environment in a more sustainable way," they added. **Bernama**
