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306 diberkas menerusi Op Kontraban sepanjang 2022

Rampas RM132.7 juta barangan bersubsidi

PETALING JAYA – Seramai 306 individu ditahan melibatkan rampasan berjumlah RM132.7 juta menerusi Op Kontraban sepanjang tahun lalu.

Setiausaha PDRM, Datuk Noorsiah Mohd. Saadudin berkata, operasi itu dilaksanakan bagi membendung ketirisan bekalan bersubsidi melibatkan Jabatan Keselamatan Dalam Negeri dan Ketenteraman Awam melalui Wildlife Crime Bureau (WCB) dan Perisikan dan Siasatan Khas (PSK).

"Rampasan tertinggi dibuat di bawah Akta Kastam iaitu sebanyak RM68,047,396.60 diikuti Akta Kawalan Bekalan (RM40,360,702.80), Akta Pemulihan Hidupan Liar (Op Bersepadu Khazanah) (RM2,855,370), Akta Bahan Letupan (RM7,576,222)

dan Akta Kualiti Alam Sekeliling 1974 (RM7,329,740).

"Rampasan turut dibuat di bawah Akta Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (RM1,500,000), Seksyen 379 dan 472 Kanun Keseksan (Bitcoin) (RM1,581,000), Peraturan-Peraturan Kawalan Dadah dan Bahan Kosmetik 1994 dan Akta Racun 1952 (RM3,420,000) Akta Senjata 1960 (RM12,000) dan Akta Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah (RM25,000)," katanya dalam kenyataan di sini semalam.

Tahun ini pula, sejak 1 hingga 6 Januari lalu, WCB dan PSK melakukan sembilan operasi membabitkan rampasan bernilai RM27,400,605.20. Seramai 23 orang ditahan dalam tempoh sama.

Individu yang diberkas terdiri daripada 17 rakyat tempatan dan enam warga asing.

"Kejayaan kes ini terdiri dari-

pada Akta Kastam 1967 membabitkan rampasan berjumlah RM24,229,455.70, Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 (RM971,149.50) dan Akta Racun 1952 (RM2,200,000)," ujarnya.

Tambah Noorsiah, pada tahun ini, WCB dan PSK akan terus komited melaksanakan operasi bersepadu bersama Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA), Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN), Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) dan Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri (LHDN).

"Usaha bersepadu dengan pihak KPDN, LHDN dan KKM khususnya merupakan langkah proaktif bagi PDRM menyumbang secara efektif dalam membendung penyelewengan minyak diesel bersubsidi, rokok dan minuman keras demi kesejahteraan rakyat, keselamatan dalam negeri dan ketenteraman awam," kata beliau.

Lebih RM27 juta barangan dirampas

Sembilan serbuan Op Kontraban dijalankan di seluruh negara pada minggu pertama 2023

Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) berjaya merampas pelbagai barangan bernilai lebih RM27 juta dalam sembilan serbuan Op Kontraban seluruh negara pada minggu pertama tahun ini dalam usaha mengekang aktiviti penyeludupan dan ketirisan barangan bersubsidi.

Setiausaha PDRM, Datuk Noorsiah Mohd Saaduddin berkata, seramai 17 warga tempatan dan enam warganegara asing

turut ditahan dalam operasi oleh Biro Kawalan Jenayah Hidupan Liar, Cawangan Perisikan dan Siasatan Khas serta Jabatan Keselamatan Dalam Negeri dan Ketenteraman Awam itu.

"Keseluruhan rampasan bernilai RM27,400,605.20

melibatkan rampasan bernilai RM24,229,455.70 di bawah Akta Kastam 1967, Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 (RM971,149.50) dan Akta Racun 1952 (RM2,200,000)," katanya dalam kenyataan di sini pada Isnin.

Noorsiah berkata, untuk Op Kontraban sepanjang tahun lalu pula, polis menahan 306 orang dan merampas pelbagai barang seludup dan bersubsidi dianggarkan bernilai lebih RM132 juta.

SMUGGLING CRACKDOWN

RM27M IN CONTRABAND SEIZED

Nationwide joint raids by police, agencies lead to arrests of 23 in first week of 2023

KUALA LUMPUR

POLICE seized contraband worth RM27 million in a series of raids across the nation in the first week of this year.

Federal police secretary Datuk Noorsiah Mohd Saaduddin said 23 people were arrested in the operation, dubbed Op Kontraban, by the Internal Security and Public Order Department.

"Between Jan 1 and 6, the Wildlife Crime Bureau and Special Investigations and Intelligence Unit carried out nine raids and the operation yielded RM27 million in seized goods.

"RM24 million of the seizures were related to the Customs Act 1967, RM971,149.50 under the Supply Control Act 1961 and

RM2.2 million under the Poison Act 1952," she said in a statement.

She said throughout last year, similar operations saw RM133 million worth of seizures involving the arrest of 306 individuals.

Noorsiah said the seizures last year comprised RM68,047,396 under the Customs Act 1967, RM25,000 under the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 1967, RM2,855,370 under the Wildlife Conservation Act 2010, RM7,576,222 under the Explosives Act 1957 and RM40,360,702 under the Control of Supplies Act 1961.

"RM1.5 million was also seized under the Malaysian Palm Oil Board Act 1998, RM1.58 million under Section 379/427 of the Penal Code for illegal bitcoin min-

ing activities, as well as RM3.4 million under the Control of Drugs and Cosmetics Regulations 1984 (for Covid medication) and Poison Act 1952 (for vape)."

For this year, she said the police

were committed to conduct integrated operations with various parties, such as the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry, Health Ministry and the Inland Revenue Board.

She said the joint effort was a proactive move for police to contribute more effectively in curbing the smuggling and siphoning of subsidised diesel fuel, cigarettes and liquor.

RM27 million in contraband seized, 23 arrested

KUALA LUMPUR: Contraband worth more than RM27 million was seized in nine raids carried out by police across the country in the first week of the year.

During the raids under an integrated operation dubbed Ops Contraband, 23 individuals, six of whom were foreigners, were also arrested.

Police secretary Datuk Noorsiah Mohd Saaduddin said the raids were aimed at curbing the smuggling of subsidised items.

"The total seizure is RM27,400,605 comprising RM24,229,455 under the Customs Act 1967, RM971,149 under the Control of Supplies Act 1961 and RM2,200,000 under the Poisons Act 1952."

She added that the same operation held in the corresponding period last year saw 306 individuals arrested with contraband worth RM132,707,431 seized.

Noorsiah said the seizures last year comprised RM68,047,396 under the Customs Act 1967, RM25,000 under the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 1967, RM2,855,370 under the Wildlife Conservation Act 2010, RM7,576,222 under the Explosives Act 1957 and RM40,360,702 under the Control of Supplies Act 1961.

"The operation also netted RM1,500,000 under the Malaysian Palm Oil Board Act 1998 and RM1,581,000 under Section 379/427 of the Penal Code for illegal bitcoin mining activities."

She also said this year, police are committed to implementing integrated operations with various other ministries and agencies, such as the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry, Health Ministry and the Inland Revenue Board.

"This is a proactive measure by the police to be more effective in curbing the smuggling of subsidised diesel, as well as contraband cigarettes and liquor for the well-being of the people, internal security and public order." - Bernama
