Dua kapal, lori tangki muatan 27,000 liter diesel dirampas

KEMAMAN: Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sarawak (KPDN) Terengganu merampas dua kapal dan dua buah lori tangki dengan muatan 27,000 liter diesel yang dianggarkan bernilai lebih RM1.7 juta di Bukit Kuang, semalam.

Pengarah KPDN negeri, Saharuddin Mohd. Kia berkata, serbuan yang dijalankan 20 penguat kuasa KPDN dan Polis DiRaja Malaysia (PDRM) itu dilakukan di dua jeti berhampiran Sungai Kuang, di sini, kira-kira pukul 5 pagi.

"Hasil serbuan mendapati lebih 10,000 liter diesel dipindahkan dari kapal ke lori tangki menggunakan paip saluran getah.

"Seramai tujuh lelaki termasuk seorang Indonesia berusia 30 hingga 40an turut ditahan bagi membantu siasatan," katanya ketika ditemui di Sungai Kuang, di sini.

Saharuddin berkata, modus operandi sindiket ini ialah membeli minyak diesel di tengah laut menggunakan kapal tunda dan minyak itu kemudiannya dipindahkan ke lori

tangki untuk dijual semula di pasaran gelap.

"Pemeriksaan lanjut mendapati kedua-dua kapal dan lori itu tidak memiliki sebarang permit atau surat kebenaran daripada Pengawal Bekalan.

"Pemeriksaan juga mendapati sebuah daripada kapal dan dua daripada pekerja lelaki itu

pernah ditahan sebelum ini dalam kes yang sama pada Jui-lai lalu," katanya.

Tegas Saharuddin, pihaknya tidak akan berkompromi dengan mana-mana pihak yang terlibat dalam sindiket haram.

Menurutnya, kes akan disiasat mengikut Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961.

KPDN confiscates subsidised cooking oil and sugar in raid

KOTA KINABALU: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) busted an operation allegedly misappropriating subsidised cooking oil and coarse granulated sugar at a house in Taman Hings, Jalan Kobusak, on Sunday.

A Sabah KPDN team raided the house at 7pm following public information regarding the sale of controlled goods in large quantities and at unreasonable prices through social media platforms.

State KPDN Director Georgie Abas said officers went undercover in the operation dubbed Op Tiris by posing as customers who were instructed to come to the address by the seller given through WhatsApp.

"The raid was carried out immediately and 8,177kg of subsidised cooking oil and 48kg of coarse granulated sugar were found stored at the house's porch and living room.

"The goods were confiscated for further

investigation as the keeper failed to show any documents or permission to buy and store the controlled items," he said in a statement.

Georgie said the total value of the seizure amounted to RM20,579 and a 27-year-old local caretaker of the premises was detained.

"The case will be investigated under Section 21 of the Supply Control Act 1961 for possessing controlled goods with the intention of committing an offence," he added.

Georgie said KPDN Sabah will continue to carry out continuous inspections and monitoring to prevent any form of misappropriation of controlled goods.

Cooking oil, sugar seized; house caretaker arrested

The Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) seized 8,177 packets of subsidised cooking oil and 48 kilogrammes of coarse granulated sugar from a house along Jalan Kobusak here on Sunday.

KOTA KINABALU: The Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) seized 8,177 packets of subsidised cooking oil and 48 kilogrammes of coarse granulated sugar from a house along Jalan Kobusak here on Sunday.

Its Sabah director, Georgie Ahad, said at around 7pm, a team of KPDN enforcement officers raided the house during Op Tiris 3.0 after receiving public information on the sale of subsidised cooking oil packets in large amount and at unreasonable prices on social media.

Georgie said one of their officers disguised as a customer had been instructed by the seller to come to a house address given through WhatsApp, and a raid was immediately carried out at the location.

"An inspection found subsidised cooking oil packets and granulated sugar stored at the sidewalk area and living

room of the house.

"These one kilogramme (kg) packets of cooking oil of various brands are estimated at 8,177 kg while the coarse granulated sugar at 48 kg, with a total estimated value of RM20,579.30.

"All of these controlled items were seized for further investigation as the house caretaker failed to produce any document or permission from KPDN to buy and store these goods at the house.

"The 27-year old local house caretaker was detained to assist the investigation," he said in a statement.

Georgie added the case is investigated under Section 21 of the Supply Control Act 1961 for possessing controlled goods with the intention of committing an offence under Act 122, which provides for any individual convicted of an offence a fine not exceeding RM1 million, while for subsequent offences not exceeding RM5 million.

not exceeding RM3 million or imprisonment of not more than three years or both.

As for companies, if found guilty, they can be fined not exceeding RM2 million, while for subsequent offenses not exceeding RM5 million.

"Sabah State KPDN will continue to carry out regular inspections and monitoring on all activities related to controlled goods in the state," he added.
